Finished Quilt Approximately: 36-1/2" x 36-12" - Finished Block Size: 4" x 4"

Happy Happy Joy Joy fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3738

## Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric

1/2 yard yellow elephant (#8795-4)  
1/2 yard blue elephant (#8795-2)  
1/2 yard pink heart (#8487-10)  
1/2 yard pink swirl (#8799-1)  
1/2 yard green dot (#8800-6)  
1/6 yard yellow swirl (#8799-4)  
1/3 yard blue dot (#8800-2)  
3/4 yard blue swirl (#8799-2)  
5/8 yard yellow flower (#8796-4)  
1-1/4 yards fabric for backing (#8795-4 yellow elephant suggested)  
40" x 40" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

## Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **yellow elephant** fabric:

Cut two 4-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into twelve 4-1/2" squares

From the **blue elephant** fabric:

Cut two 4-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into twelve 4-1/2" squares

From the **pink heart** fabric:

Cut one 3-1/4" x 44" strips recut into twelve 3-1/4" squares\*\*

Cut four 1-1/4" x 44" strips for border

From the **pink swirl** fabric:

Cut one 3-1/4" x 44" strips recut into twelve 3-1/4" squares\*\*

Cut two 2-7/8" x 44" strips recut into twenty-four 2-7/8" squares\*

From the **green dot** fabric:

Cut one 3-1/4" x 44" strips recut into eight 3-1/4" squares\*\*

Cut two 2-7/8" x 44" strips recut into sixteen 2-7/8" squares\*

From the **yellow swirl** fabric:

Cut one 3-1/4" x 44" strips recut into eight 3-1/4" squares\*\*

From the **blue dot** fabric:

Cut one 3-1/4" x 44" strips recut into five 3-1/4" squares\*\*

Cut one 2-7/8" x 44" strips recut into ten 2-7/8" squares\*

From the **blue swirl** fabric:

Cut one 3-1/4" x 44" strips recut into five 3-1/4" squares\*\*

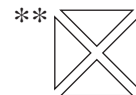
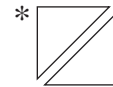
Cut four 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Cut four 1-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **yellow flower** fabric:

Cut four 3" x 44" strips for border

Cut squares  
as indicated

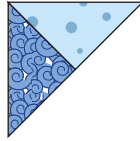


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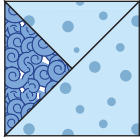
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## Pinwheel Blocks:

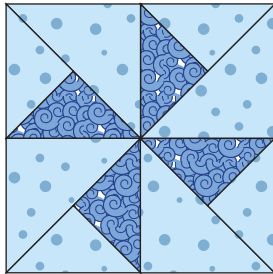
1. Sew a blue swirl 3-1/4" quarter-square triangle to each of the blue dot 3-1/4" quarter square triangle.



2. Add a 2-7/8" blue dot half-square triangle to each triangle unit.

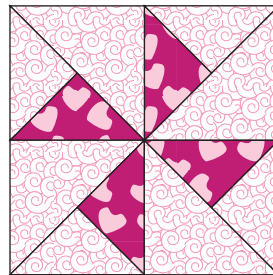


3. Lay out four pinwheel sections to form a block as shown. Stitch the squares into rows then sew the rows together to complete the block.

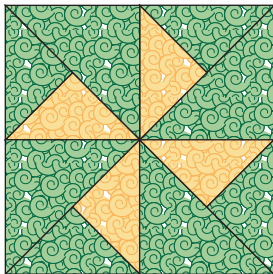


4. Make a total of five blue blocks.

5. Using the pink heart and pink swirl triangles make a total of twelve pink blocks in the same manner as the blue pinwheel blocks.



6. Using the green swirl and yellow swirl triangles make a total of eight green blocks in the same manner as the blue pinwheel blocks.



## Quilt Center:

1. Lay out all the pinwheel blocks with the blue and yellow 4-1/2" elephant squares as shown in the quilt layout.

2. Stitch the blocks into rows. Sew the rows together.

## Borders:

1. Stitch a 1-1/4" pink heart strip to right and left sides of quilt. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions. Add remaining 1-1/4" pink heart strips to the top and bottom of quilt, press and trim excess.

2. Add a 3" yellow floral border in the same manner as the first border.

3. Add a 1-1/2" blue swirl border in the same manner as the first border.

## Finishing:

1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from four 2-1/2" x 44" strips of blue swirl. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
