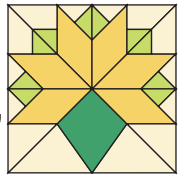

Finished Quilt Approximately: 63-1/2" x 77-1/4" - Finished Block Size: 12" x 12"

Fanfare fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3724



Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric

- 7/8 yard large floral (#8701-6)
- 1/2 yard pink mini paisley (#8702-1)
- 3/8 yard green mini paisley (#8702-6)
- 3/4 yard light pink mini paisley (#8702-10)
- 1 yard pink lines (#8706-1)
- 1-1/3 yards yellow lines (#8706-4)
- 1-1/4 yards green dots (#8705-6)
- 1 yard yellow dots (#8705-6)
- 3/4 yard yellow paisley floral (#8704-4)
- 2-1/4 yard pink border stripe (#8703-1)
- 4-1/4 yards fabric for backing (#8701-6 large floral suggested)
- 4 x 6" piece of fusible web
- 70" x 84" quilt batting
- template plastic

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Make Templates: Trace templates onto template plastic. Cut out and label.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **large floral** fabric:

Cut three 6-1/2" x 44" strips recut into twelve 6-1/2" x 8" rectangles

From the **mini pink paisley** fabric:

Cut two 5" x 44" strips recut into twelve 5" x 6-1/2" rectangles

From the **green mini paisley** fabric:

Cut one 6-1/2" x 44" strips, one 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece and reserve remaining strip

From the **light pink mini paisley** fabric:

Cut six 2-3/4" x 44" strips for borders

From the **pink lines** fabric:

Cut two 5" x 44" strips recut into twelve 5" squares

Cut two 3-1/2" x 44" strips recut into twenty-four 3-1/2" squares

Cut two 2" x 44" strips recut into twenty-four 2" squares

From the **yellow lines** fabric:

Cut one 4-3/8" x 44" strips then recut into six 4-3/8" squares*

Cut two 4" x 44" strips for cutting templates

Cut two 2-5/8" x 44" strips recut into eighteen 2-5/8" squares*

Cut six 2-1/2" x 44" strips for border

Cut three 2-1/4" x 44" strips recut into twenty-four 2-1/4" x 4" rectangles

From the **green dots** fabric:

Cut two 2-5/8" x 44" strips recut thirty 2-5/8" squares*

Cut seven 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Cut eight 1-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **yellow dots** fabric:

Cut eleven 2-1/4" x 44" strips recut into thirty-one 2-1/4" x 12-1/2" sashing strips and twenty 2-1/4" sashing cornerstone squares

From the **yellow paisley floral** fabric:

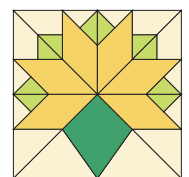
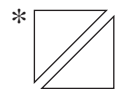
Cut one 5-1/2" x 44" strip recut into four 5-1/2" squares for border cornerstones

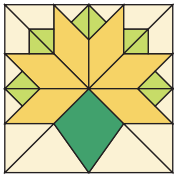
Cut four 3" x 44" strips for cutting templates

From the **pink border stripe** fabric:

Fussy cut four 5-1/2" x 72" border strips *lengthwise* - parallel to the border

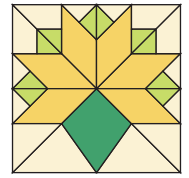
Cut squares as indicated:






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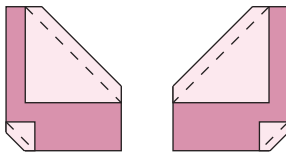
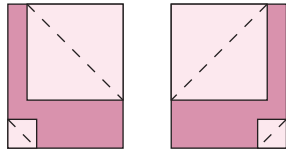


Butterfly Blocks:

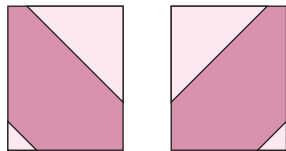
1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the 5", 3-1/2" and 2" pink line squares. 

2. The two halves of the butterfly blocks are mirror images of each other. Diagrams will show each side of the block. Make six of each half.

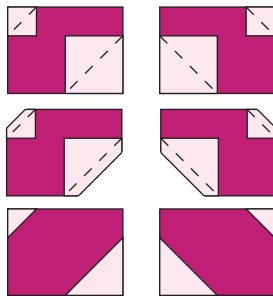
3. Lay a marked 5" and 2" pink line square on each of the 6-1/2" x 8" large floral rectangles (six each) as shown.



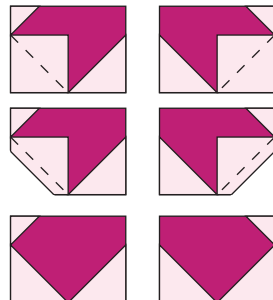
Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out.



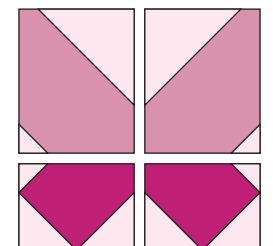
4. Lay a 2" and 3-1/2" pink line square on each of the 5" x 6-1/2" pink paisley rectangles as shown (six each). Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out.



5. Lay another 3-1/2" pink line square as shown on the pink paisley units. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out.

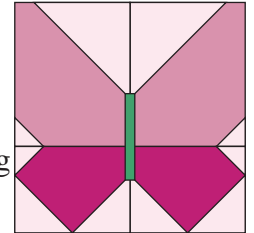


6. Lay out two top units and two bottom units as shown. Stitch together to make butterfly block. Make a total of six blocks.



7. Lightly press the web side of fusible web to the wrong side of remaining green mini paisley fabric. Using a rotary cutter, cut six 1/2" x 5-1/2" strips of green with the fusible web.

8. Position a green strip over each butterfly block as shown. Trim to fit. Permanently press the green strip in place following web manufacturer's directions.



9. Machine stitch the raw edges of green strips using a zig zag or other overcast stitch. Use a neutral all-purpose thread in the bobbin and a clear nylon or matching all-purpose thread through the needle.

Nosegay Blocks:

1. Using Template A, cut eighteen diamonds from two 3" x 44" yellow paisley floral strips.



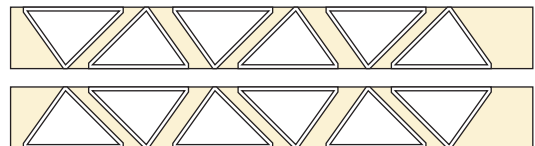
2. Using *Template A face down*, cut eighteen diamonds from two 3" x 44" yellow paisley floral strips.

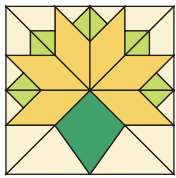


3. Cut six Template B from the remaining 6-1/2" green mini paisley strip.



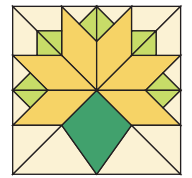
4. From the 4" x 44" yellow line strips, cut six Template C and six *Template C face down*.



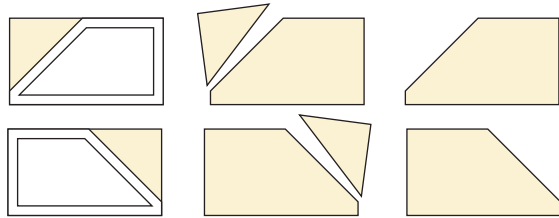


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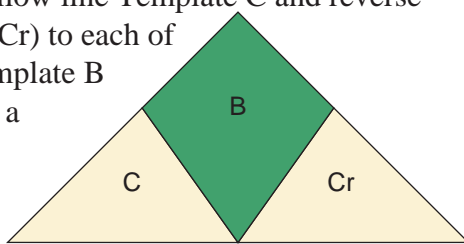

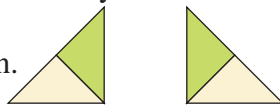
5. Trim twelve 2-1/4" x 4" yellow line pieces with Template D. Trim the remaining 2-1/4" x 4" yellow line pieces with the *Template D* face down.



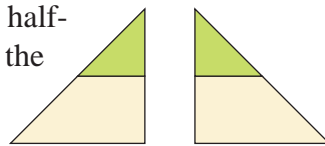
6. Stitch a yellow line Template C and reverse Template C (Cr) to each of the green Template B pieces. Make a total of six base units.



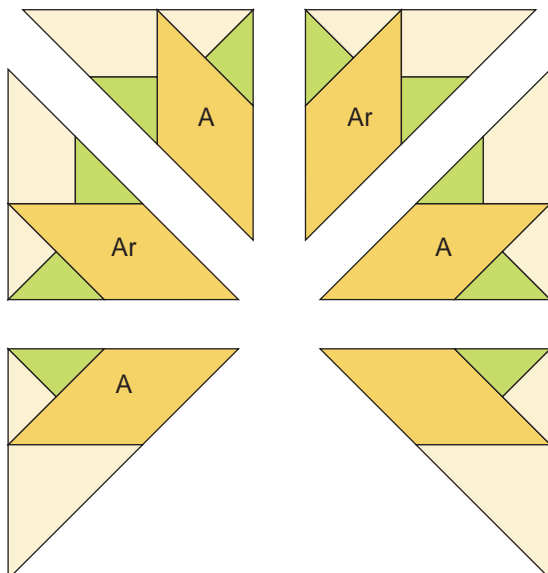
7. Sew thirty-six green dot and yellow line 2-5/8" half-square triangles - 18 of each configuration.



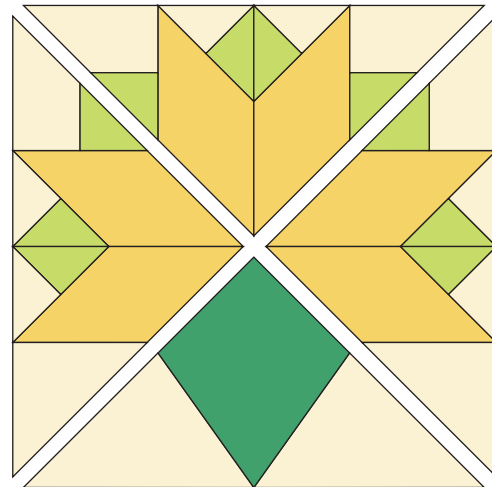
8. Add a green dot 2-5/8" half-square triangle to each of the 2-1/4" x 4" yellow line trimmed rectangles.



9. To Template A and reverse Template A (Ar) yellow diamonds add a combination of 4-3/8" yellow line half-square triangles and the green/yellow units made above to make SIX of each of the sections shown below:



10. Lay out one of each section for the Nosegay Blocks as shown. Stitch the diamond units into the quarter block sections as shown. Stitch the four quarters together. Make a total of six blocks.

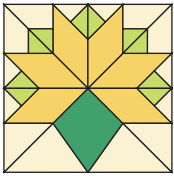


Assembly and Borders:

1. Using the quilt diagram as guide, lay out all the blocks into four horizontal rows of three blocks each. Between and around the blocks, lay out the 2-1/4" x 12-1/2" yellow dot sashing strips. Between the sashing strips, place the 2-1/4" yellow dot sashing cornerstones. Stitch all the blocks, sashing strips and sashing cornerstones into rows. Sew the rows together.

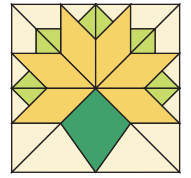
2. Cut two 2-1/2" x 44" yellow line strips each into two equal halves. Sew each half-length strip end-to-end with the four remaining full-length strips. Add these to the right and left sides of the quilt center. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions. Add yellow line borders to the top and bottom of quilt.

3. Make and add a 2-3/4" light pink mini paisley border in the same manner as the first border.



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4. Trim two 5-1/2" x 72" border strips the width of the quilt center (about 51-3/4" long). Add a 5-1/2" yellow paisley floral square to each end of the two trimmed strips. Set these aside of the top and bottom borders.

NOTE: Border stripe strips should be added to the quilt center so similar edges of the borders are stitched to the quilt center.

5. Sew 5-1/2" x 72" border strips to the right and left sides of the quilt center. Press and trim excess. Add the prepared top and bottom borders.

6. Make four 1-1/2" x 44" green dot strip border, each with two strips sewn together end-to-end. Add borders to the right and left sides, then to the top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

1. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Sew the two lengths together along selvage edges. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from seven 2-1/2" x 44" strips of green dots. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

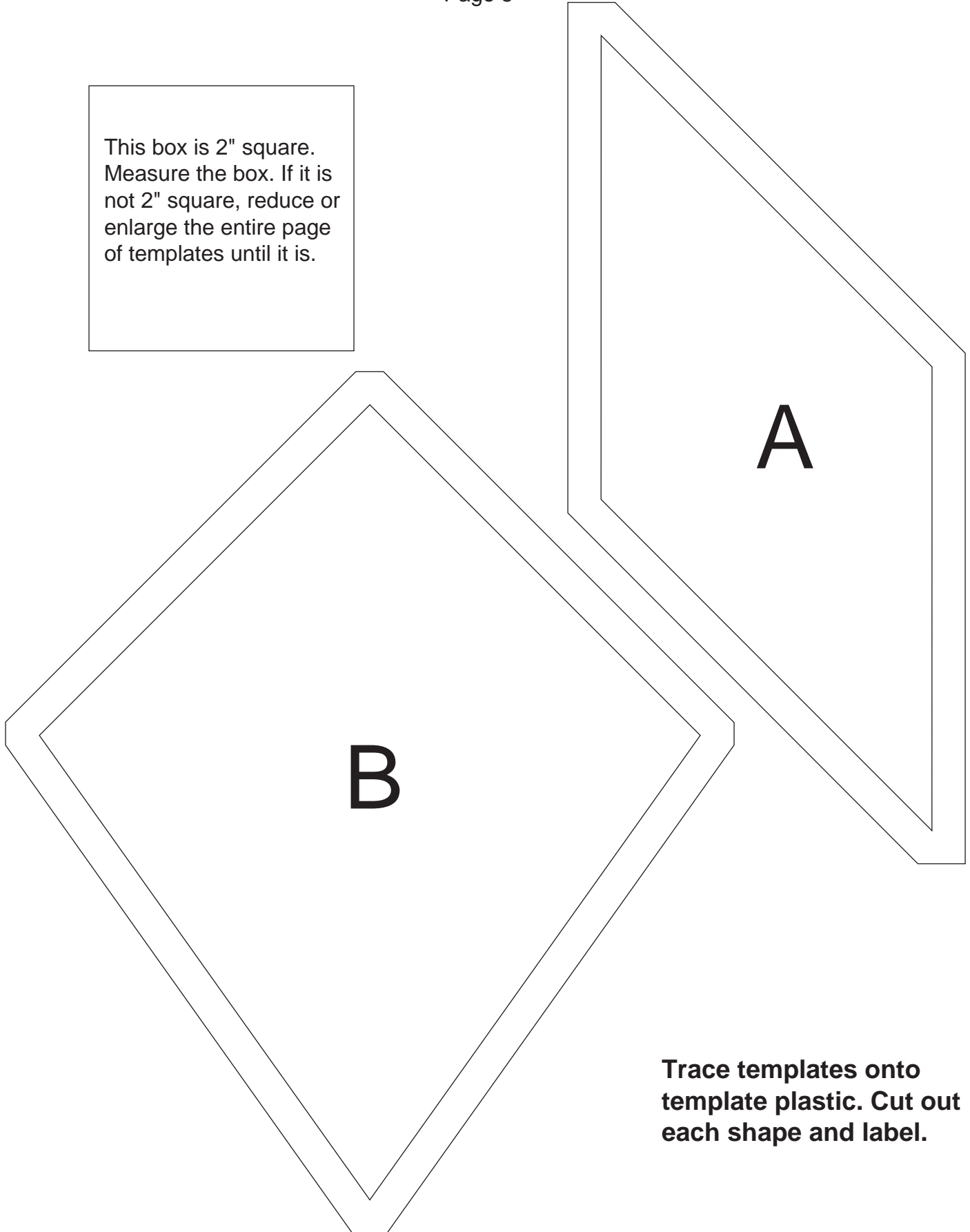
4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.

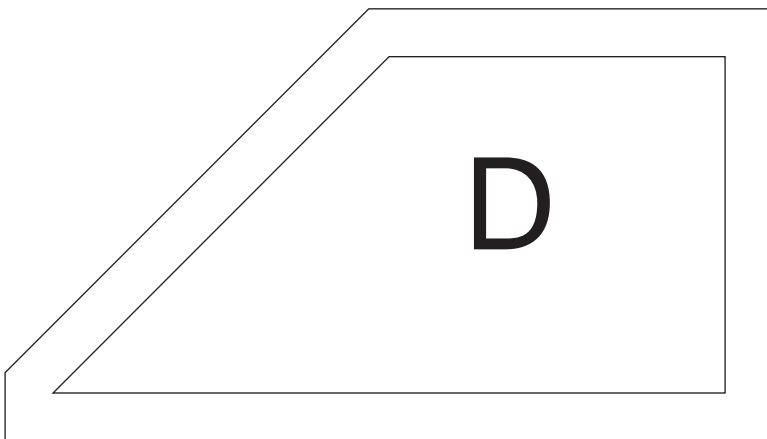
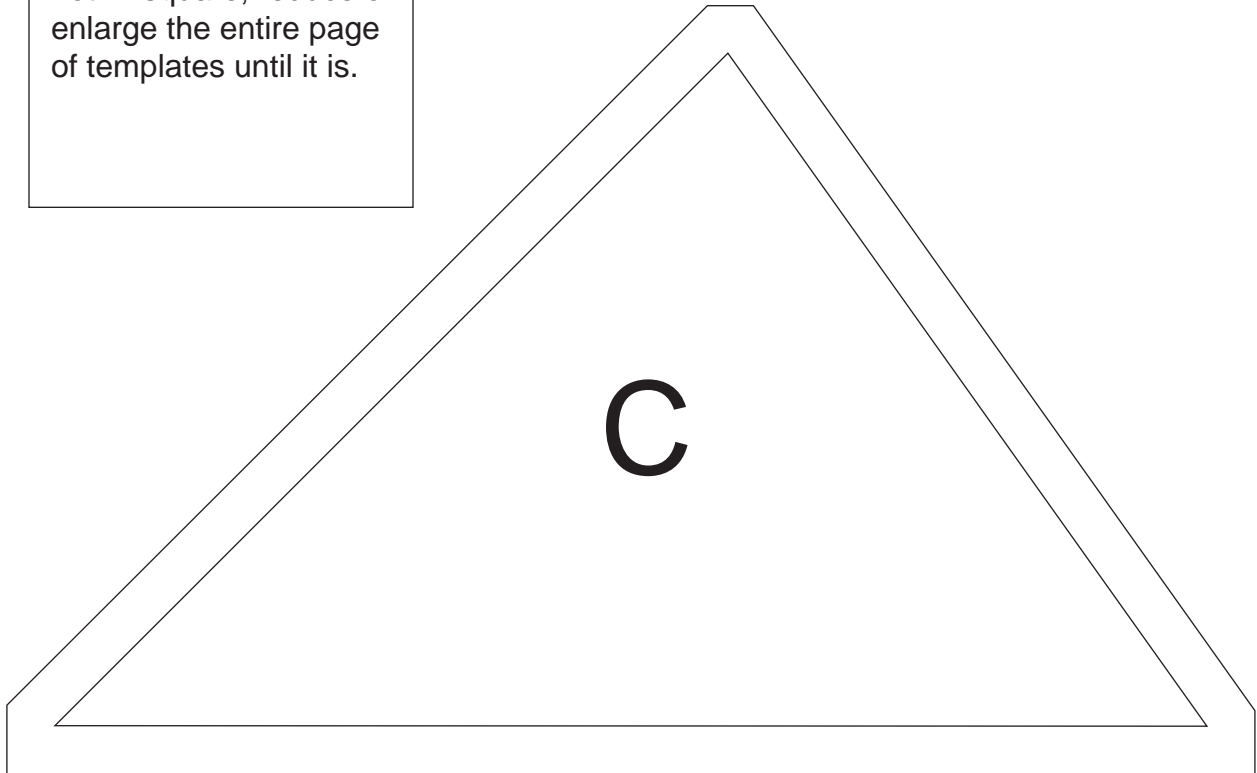
