

Pillowcases

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PILLOWCASE SIZES

Standard - 21" X 30"

Queen - 21" X 34"

King - 21" X 40"

FABRIC

Standard - $\frac{3}{4}$ yard main fabric

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard band

Queen - $\frac{7}{8}$ yard main body

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard band

King - 1 yard main body

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard band

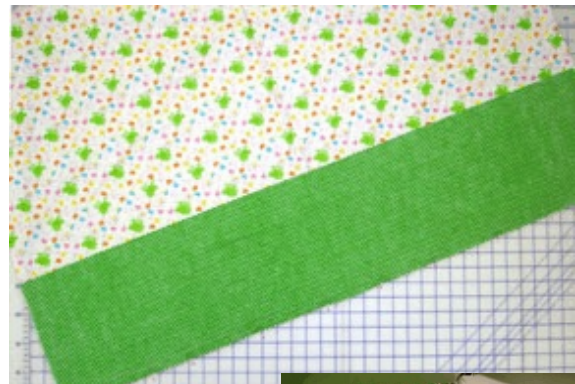
CUTTING

Lay out main body fabric with band on the top. Cut selvages off both pieces. Square up sides if necessary.



CONSTRUCTION

1. Place the right side of the band to the right side of the main body. Pin together. Keep the edge of your presser foot on the raw edge of fabric. This makes an easy to measure seam allowance. Sew the long side



of the band to the main pillowcase body.

2. Roll up main pillowcase fabric, small enough that it fits inside the band fabric. Pin right sides of band fabric together on the raw edges. Sew on your first stitch line.



3. Pull to the right side and press.



4. Pin right sides together and seam side and end.



Clip corner.



5. Turn to the right side and press.



OPTIONS

1. Cut an accent piece 2" X width of fabric. Trim to the same length as pillowcase body and band. Press in half lengthwise, wrong sides together. Pin between main pillowcase fabric and band. It sews in when the band is seamed to the main pillowcase body.

* Sample in the photos has an inserted accent piece.

2. Before seaming the side and end of pillowcase, add a piece of trim at the seam line. Fluffy, fuzzy trim works great.

3. Cut 5" squares to make prairie points. Slightly over lap them. Pin between main pillowcase fabric and band. They sew in when the band is seamed to the main pillowcase body.
