Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric

Four Wolf Song Pillow Panels (#8754-9)

2-3/8 yards forest scenic (#8756-9)

1-1/4 yards wolf scenic (#8755-6)

2 yards black paw print (#8760-8)

3/4 yard soft gold (#8759-9)

3/4 yard fern (#8758-6)

1 yard brown (#8760-99)

1/3 yard light green (#8759-6)

3/8 yard green paw print (#8760-6)

5-1/4 yards fabric for backing (#8756-9 forest scenic suggested)

88" x 88" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **forest scenic** fabric:

Cut two 6-1/2" x 76" strips *lengthwise*, parallel to the selvage

From remaining fabric cut:

Cut one 20-1/2" square for center quilt block

Cut six 6-1/2" the remaining width, about 30" wide

From the **wolf scenic** fabric:

Fussy cut four 10-1/2" squares

From the **black** fabric:

Cut two 6-1/4" x 44" strips recut into eight 6-1/4" squares**

Cut three 3-3/8" x 44" strips recut into thirty-two 3-3/8" squares*

Cut two 3" x 44" strips then recut one strip into sixteen 3" squares

Cut nine 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Cut eight 1-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **soft gold** fabric:

Cut eight 2" x 44" strips for border

From the **fern** fabric:

Cut three 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into sixteen 5-7/8" squares*

From the **brown** fabric:

Cut two 3-3/8" x 44" strips then recut into sixteen 3-3/8" squares*

Cut seven 3" x 44" strips for border

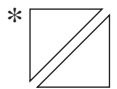
From the **light green** fabric:

Cut two 3" x 44" strips then recut into sixteen 3" squares

From the **green paw print** fabric:

Cut two 3-3/8" x 44" strips recut into sixteen 3-3/8" squares*

Cut squares
as indicated:

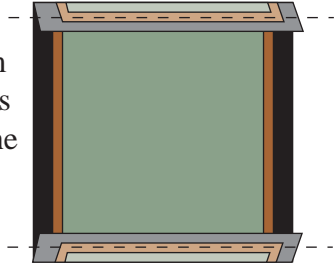

Wolf Blocks:

1. Fold the top and bottom of a wolf panel (right sides in) so just under 1/4" of the inside wolf picture shows along the fold. Press the folds.



2. Stitch both top and bottom 1/4" from the folded edges. Press tucks away from the centers.

3. Trim panel to 20-1/2" x 20-1/2" - approximately between the brown and black lines. It is okay if there is some black remaining on the panel as long as it is less than the 1/4" seam allowance.

Star Blocks:

1. Stitch a 3-3/8" black half-square triangle to each of the thirty-two 3-3/8" green paw print half-square triangles.



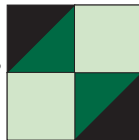
2. Combine two green/black units with two 3" black squares to make a total of eight four-patch units.



3. Stitch a 3" light green square to each of the remaining green/black units.



4. Combine two light green/triangle units to make a total of eight four-patch units.



5. Sew two 3-3/8" brown half-square triangles to each of sixteen 6-1/4" black quarter-square triangles.



6. Add a 6-1/4" black quarter-square triangle to the top of each of these sixteen units.



7. Sew 3-3/8" black half-square triangles to each side of the base of the units.



8. Stitch 5-7/8" fern half-square triangles to complete each of the star points units.



9. Refer to the block diagrams on Page 3. Each block uses one 10-1/2" wolf scenic square, four star point units and two each of the four-patch units. Lay out each block individually then sew the units/squares into rows then sew the rows into the finished block.

Quilt Center and Borders:

1. Lay out all the blocks as shown in the quilt layout. Stitch into rows, then sew rows together.

2. Cut one 3" x 44" brown strip into two equal halves. Sew each half to a full-length strip. Stitch these to the right and left sides of quilt. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions. Make two borders each with two 3" x 44" brown strips sewn together end-to-end. Add these borders to top and bottom of quilt.

3. Make four borders each with two 2" x 44" soft gold strips. Add borders to right and left sides then to top and bottom of quilt.

4. Stitch 6-1/2" x 76" forest scenic strips to right and left sides of quilt. Piece two border strips each with three 6-1/2" x 30" forest scenic strips end-to-end, matching the print as much as possible. Add these borders to the top and bottom of quilt.

5. Make four borders each with two 1-1/2" x 44" black strips. Add to sides then top and bottom.

Finishing:

1. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Sew the two lengths together along selvage edges. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from nine 2-1/2" x 44" strips of black. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.

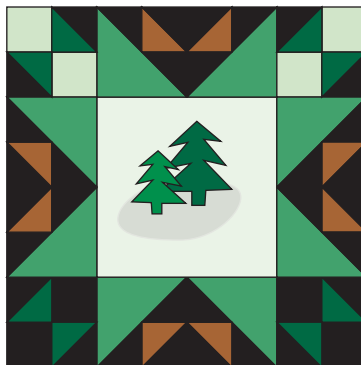
STAR BLOCK DIAGRAMS - MAKE ONE EACH



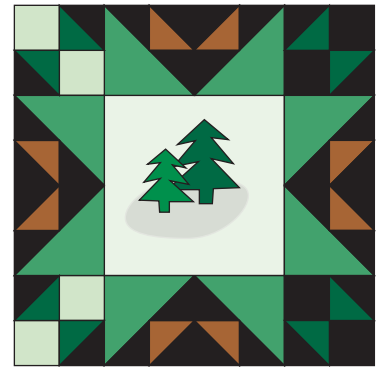
Left Block
