Finished Quilt Approximately: 66" x 76" - Finished Block Size: 10" x 10"

30's Quilt Collection III fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3695

Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric

1-3/4 yards white strawberry (#8573-9)
1/2 yard pink flowers (#8572-1)
2-1/2 yards black bubbles (#8574-8)
1/3 yard blue dot (#8575-2)
5/8 yard yellow parachute (#8570-4)
5/8 yard green dot (#8575-6)
3/4 yard pink parachute (#8570-1)
1/4 yard yellow strawberry (#8573-4)
1/2 yard blue parachute (#8570-2)
1/2 yard yellow flowers (#8572-4)
1 yard green flowers (#8572-6)
1/2 yard blue flowers (#8572-2)
4-1/4 yards fabric for backing (#8570-4 yellow parachute suggested)
70" x 82" quilt batting
template plastic

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Make Templates: Trace templates onto template plastic. Cut out and label.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **white strawberry** fabric:

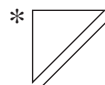
Cut one 6-1/4" x 44" strips recut into four 6-1/4" squares**

Cut four 5" x 44" strips

Cut one 4-3/8" x 44" strip recut into eight 4-3/8" squares*

Cut two 3-1/2" x 44" strips recut into sixteen 3-1/2" squares

Cut six 2-1/2" x 44" strips for border



From the **pink flowers** fabric:

Cut one 5-1/8" x 44" strip

Cut one 4" x 44" strip recut into five 4" squares

From the **black bubbles** fabric:

Cut one 6-1/4" x 44" strips recut into four 6-1/4" squares**

Cut three 5" x 44" strips

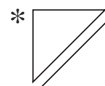
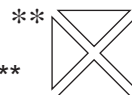
Cut one 4-1/2" x 44" strips recut into four 4-1/2" squares

Cut one 4-3/8" x 44" strip recut into seven 4-3/8" squares*

Cut two 3-1/2" x 44" strips recut into fourteen 3-1/2" squares

Cut eight 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Cut fifteen 1-1/2" x 44" strips for borders



From the **blue dot** fabric:

Cut one 5-1/8" x 44" strip

From the **yellow parachute** fabric:

Cut one 5-1/8" x 44" strip

Cut two 4-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **green dot** fabric:

Cut two 5" x 44" strips

Cut two 1-1/2" x 44" strips recut into eight 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips

Cutting directions continued on Page 4

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Bloom Blocks:

1. From the 5-1/8" x 44" strips, cut the following number of templates from fabrics listed:

Template A: Cut 5 blue dot
Cut 5 pink flowers
Cut 5 yellow parachutes

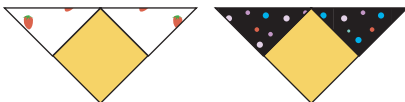


Template B: Cut 5 blue parachutes
Cut 5 pink parachutes
Cut 5 yellow flowers

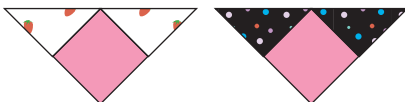


2. Using the 4" yellow strawberry, pink flowers and green flowers squares - add two background 6-1/4" quarter-square triangles as shown:

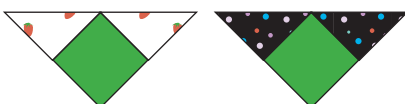
Yellow: two white background & three black background



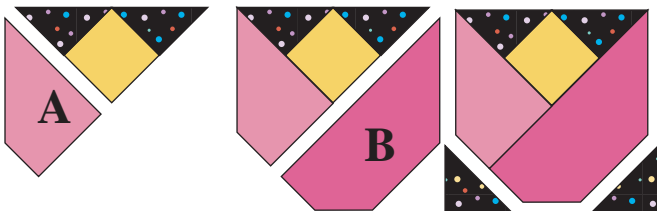
Pink: three white background & two black background



Green: three white background & two black background



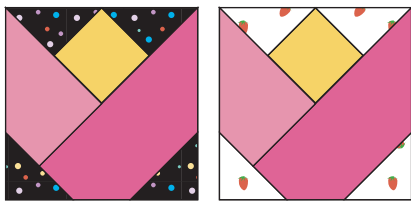
3. To finish each Bloom Block add a Template A piece then a Template B piece. Add a 4-3/8" half-square triangle to the bottom corners.



4. Make the number of each block as shown here and the top of next column.

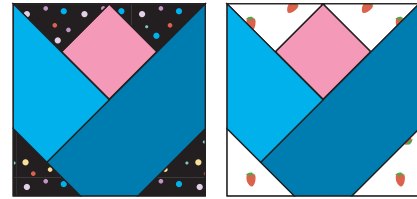
Pink Blooms:

3 on black
2 on white



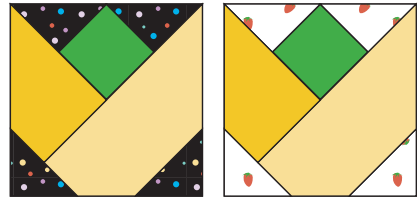
Blue Blooms:

2 on black
3 on white



Yellow Blooms:

2 on black
3 on white



Stem Blocks:

1. From 5" x 44" strips cut the following:

Template C & C-r: Cut 8 each white strawberry
Cut 7 each black bubble

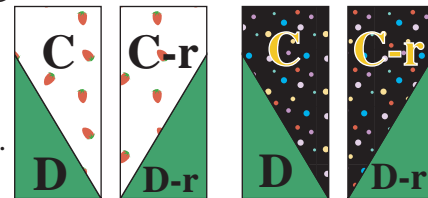


Template D & D-r: Cut 8 each green dot
Cut 7 each green flowers



2. Using the pieces cut in the last step, stitch them into the following units: **Make 8 leaf units** with white strawberry

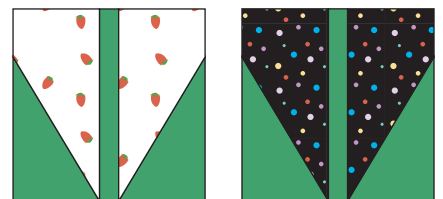
C and C-r pieces and green dot D and D-r pieces.



Make 7 leaf

units with black bubbles C and C-r pieces and green flowers D and Dr pieces.

3. Stitch a green 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" green strip between the two leaf units using the same green print in the leaves for a total of eight blocks with white background and seven with a black background.



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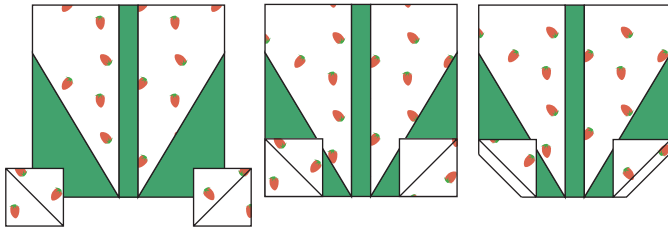
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Stem Blocks: (continued)

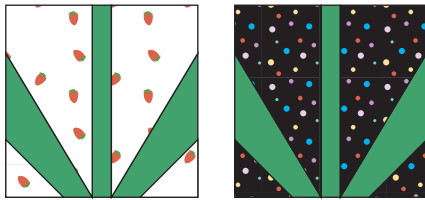
4. Mark a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the 3-1/2" white strawberry and black bubble blocks.



5. On the blocks with a white strawberry background, lay two marked 3-1/2" white strawberry squares on the two bottom corners of the block as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to about 1/4" and press seam to newly formed triangle corner.



6. Repeat with black background blocks. Make a total of eight white stem blocks and seven black stem blocks.



Finishing:

1. Lay out all the Bloom and Stem blocks as shown in quilt diagram. Stitch blocks into rows then sew the rows together.
2. Cut two 2-1/2" white strawberry strips each into two equal halves. Sew each half-length strip end-to-end with a full-length strip. Add borders to the right and left sides. Press and trim these and all successive border addition. Add remaining borders to the top and bottom of quilt.
3. Make six borders each with two 1-1/2" black bubble strips sewn together end-to-end. Set aside four borders for final border. Add two double-length borders to the right and left sides of quilt. Cut one 1-1/2" x 44" black bubble strip into two equal lengths and stitch each to a full-length strip. Add these to top and bottom of quilt.

4. Make one double-length 4-1/2" border of each of these fabrics: yellow parachutes, pink parachutes, green flowers and blue flowers. Trim the yellow and pink borders equal to the width of the quilt. Add a 4-1/2" black bubble square to the ends of each trimmed border. Stitch the blue border to right side of quilt and green border to left side of quilt, press and trim. Add the prepared yellow border to the top and prepared pink border to the bottom.

5. Add the four double-length 1-1/2" black bubble borders made in step #2.

6. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Sew the two lengths together along selvage edges. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

7. Prepare binding from eight 2-1/2" x 44" strips of black bubble. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

8. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

9. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

10. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.

From the **pink parachute** fabric:

Cut two 5-1/8" x 44" strips

Cut two 4-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **yellow strawberry** fabric:

Cut one 4" x 44" strip recut into five 4" squares

From the **blue parachutes** fabric:

Cut two 5-1/8" x 44" strips

From the **yellow flowers** fabric:

Cut two 5-1/8" x 44" strips

From the **green flowers** fabric:

Cut two 5" x 44" strips

Cut one 4" x 44" strip recut into five 4" squares

Cut two 4-1/2" x 44" strips for border

Cut two 1-1/2" x 44" strips recut into seven 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips

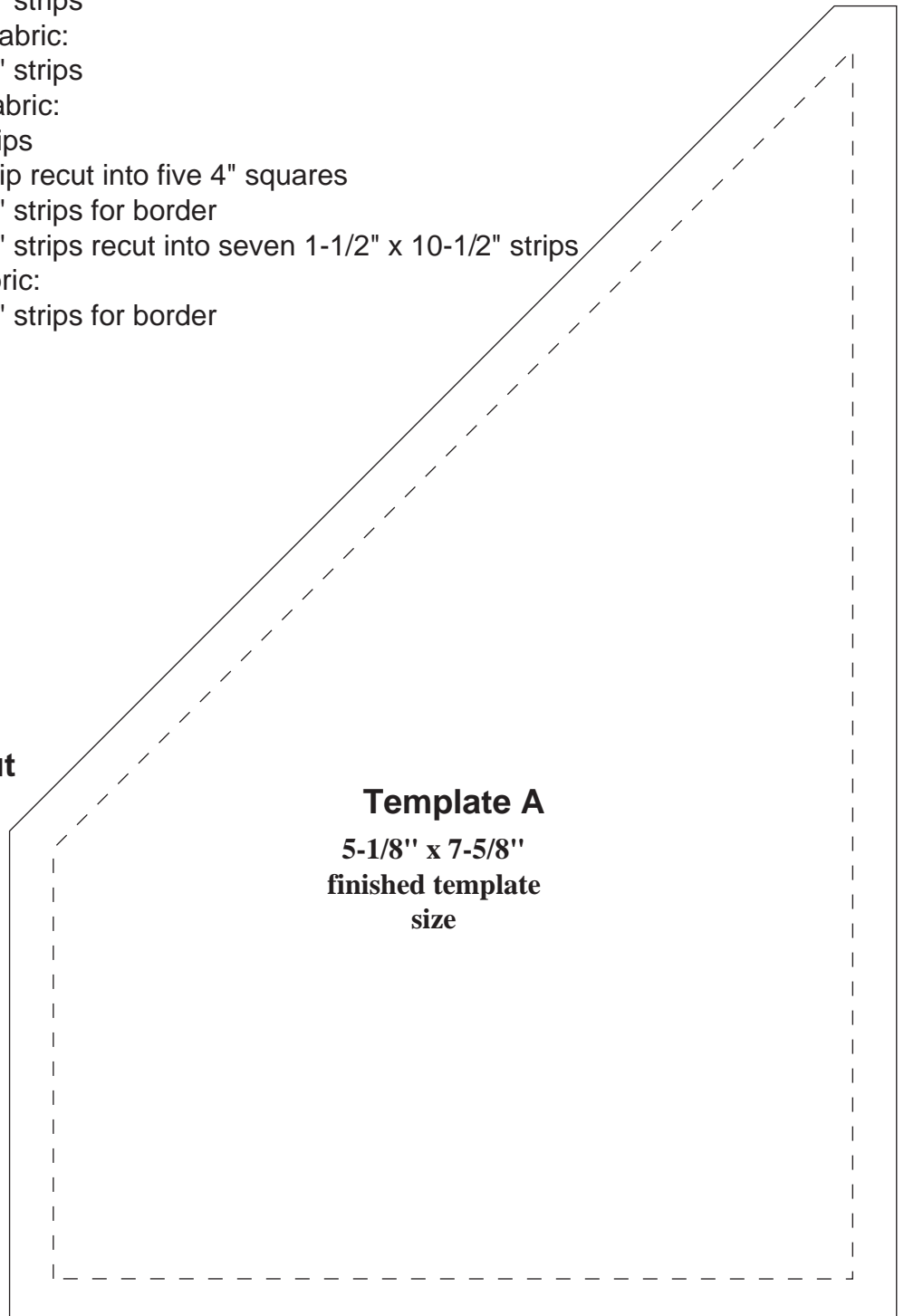
From the **blue flowers** fabric:

Cut two 4-1/2" x 44" strips for border

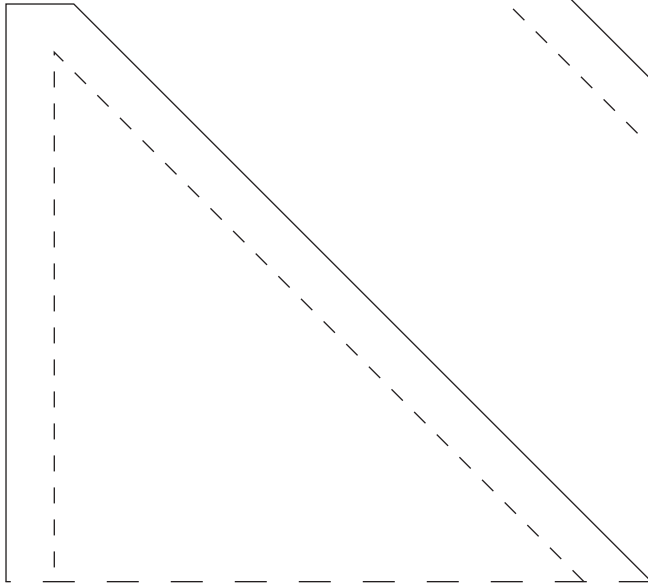
Template A

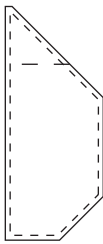

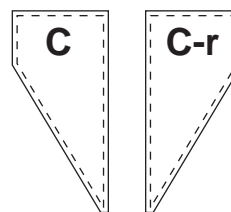
**Long dotted line is where

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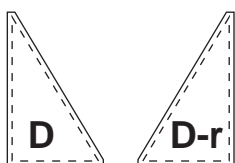
