Finished Quilt: 40" x 40" - Finished Block Size: 10" x 10"

Always Lovely fabrics by Classic Cottons - Style #3660

Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric

1/2 yard green dot print (#8374-6)

7/8 yard coral dot print (#8374-7)

2/3 yard cream dot print (#8374-9)

3/8 yard light coral print (#8372-7)

3/8 yard light green print (#8372-6)

3/8 yard dark green floral (#8369-6)

7/8 yards large floral (#8368-7)

3/8 yard cream floral bouquet (#8370-7)

1/2 yard coral floral bouquet (#8370-79)

3/8 yard coral on cream toile (#8371-7)

1-1/4 yards fabric for backing (#8368-7 large floral suggested)

42" x 42" quilt batting

template plastic

Make Templates: Trace templates onto template plastic. Cut out and label.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the green dot fabric:

Cut one 5-1/2" x 44" strip then recut into eight 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles

Cut one 4-1/2" x 44" strip then recut into four 4-1/2" squares and one 4" square

From the coral dot fabric:

Cut one 4-1/2" x 44" strip recut into two 4-1/2" squares

Cut four 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Cut four 1-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the cream dot fabric:

Cut one 5-1/2" x 44" strip then recut into eight 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles

Cut one 3-3/8" x 44" strip then recut into twelve 3-3/8" squares

Cut one 3" x 44" strip then recut into eight 3" squares

From the light coral fabric:

Cut one 5-1/2" x 44" strip then recut into eight 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles and two 4-1/2" squares

From the light green fabric:

Cut one 5-1/2" x 44" strip then recut into eight 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles

From the dark green floral fabric:

Cut one 5-7/8" x 44" strip then recut into two 5-7/8" squares and four 3" squares

From the large floral fabric:

Cut one 6" x 44" strips then recut into eight 4" x 6" rectangles

Cut four 4-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the cream floral bouquet fabric:

Cut one 6" x 44" strip then recut into eight 4" x 6" rectangles

From the coral floral bouquet fabric:

Cut two 4" x 44" strips then recut into four 4" x 6" rectangles and four 4" squares

From the coral on cream toile fabric:

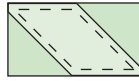
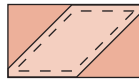
Cut one 4-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into two 4-1/2" squares

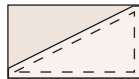
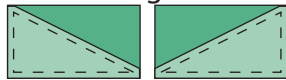

Flower Block:

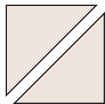
1. Trim each light coral 3" x 5-1/2" rectangle with Diamond A Template. Trim each light green 3" x 5-1/2" rectangle with Diamond B Template.



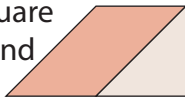
Trim four 3" x 5-1/2" green dot rectangles with Triangle C Template and four with the Triangle D Template. Trim four 3" x 5-1/2" cream dot rectangles with Triangle C Template and four with the Triangle D Template.



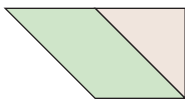
2. Cut all 3-3/8" squares, 4-1/2" and 5-7/8" squares in half diagonally once.



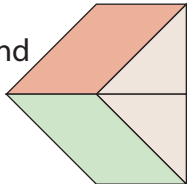
3. Sew a 3-3/8" cream dot half-square triangle to each light coral diamond as shown.



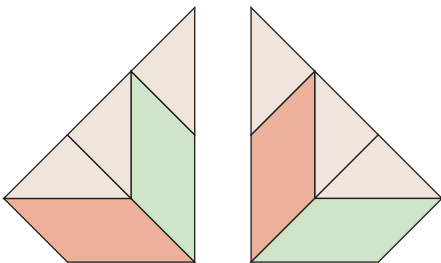
4. Sew a 3-3/8" cream dot half-square triangle to each light green diamond as shown.



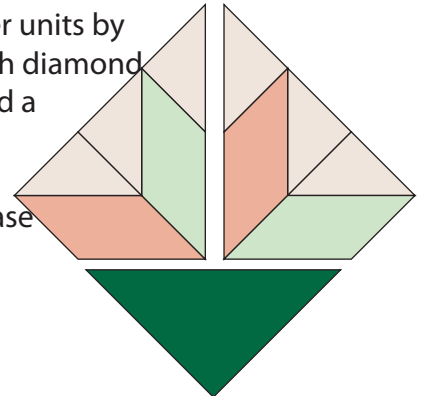
5. Combine a light coral diamond section with each light green diamond.



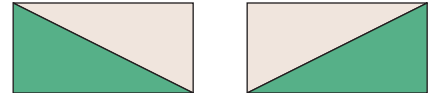
6. Sew a 3-3/8" cream dot half-square triangle to each of the diamond units - four to the light green diamond and four to the light coral diamond.



7. Make four flower units by sewing one of each diamond units together. Add a 5-7/8" dark green half-square diamond to the base of each unit.



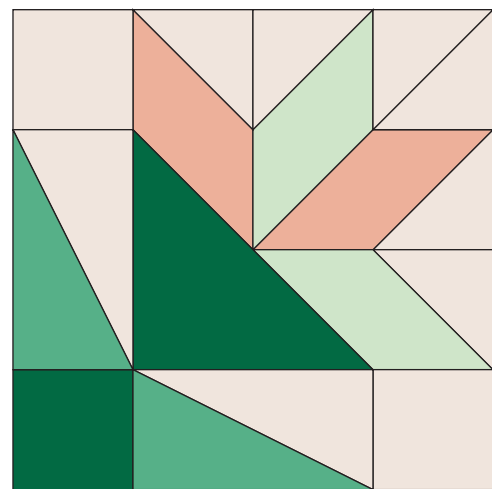
8. Sew each Triangle C to a Triangle D making eight green/cream triangle sets - four of each configuration.



9. Sew a 3" cream dot square to the cream end of each green/cream triangle set.



10. Lay out a flower unit, one of each leaf unit and a 3" dark green square as shown. Stitch units together. Make a total of four Flower Blocks.

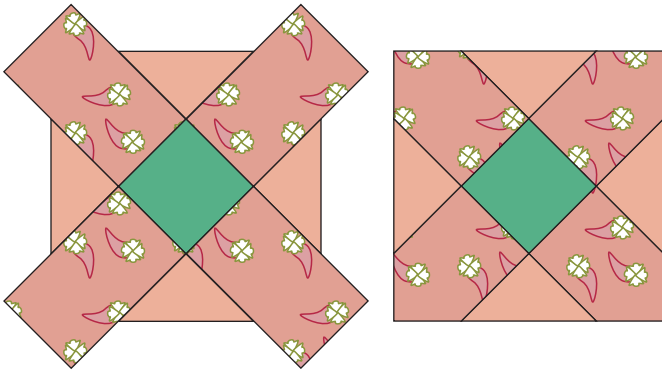

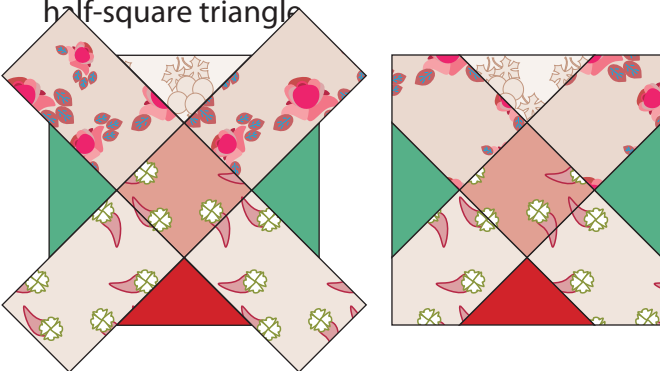
Center "X" Block:

1. Lay out a 4" green dot square, four 4" x 6" coral floral bouquet rectangles and four light coral print 4-1/2" half-square triangles. Stitch the pieces together into diagonal rows. Sew the rows together matching seam allowances. Trim block to 10-1/2" square. Make only one Center "X" Block.



Outside "X" Blocks:

1. Using the same technique as outlined above, make four Outside "X" blocks, each with one 4" coral floral bouquet square, two 4" x 6" cream floral bouquet rectangles, two 4" x 6" large floral rectangles, two green dot 4-1/2" half-square triangles, one coral dot 4-1/2" half-square triangle and one coral on cream toile 4-1/2" half-square triangle.



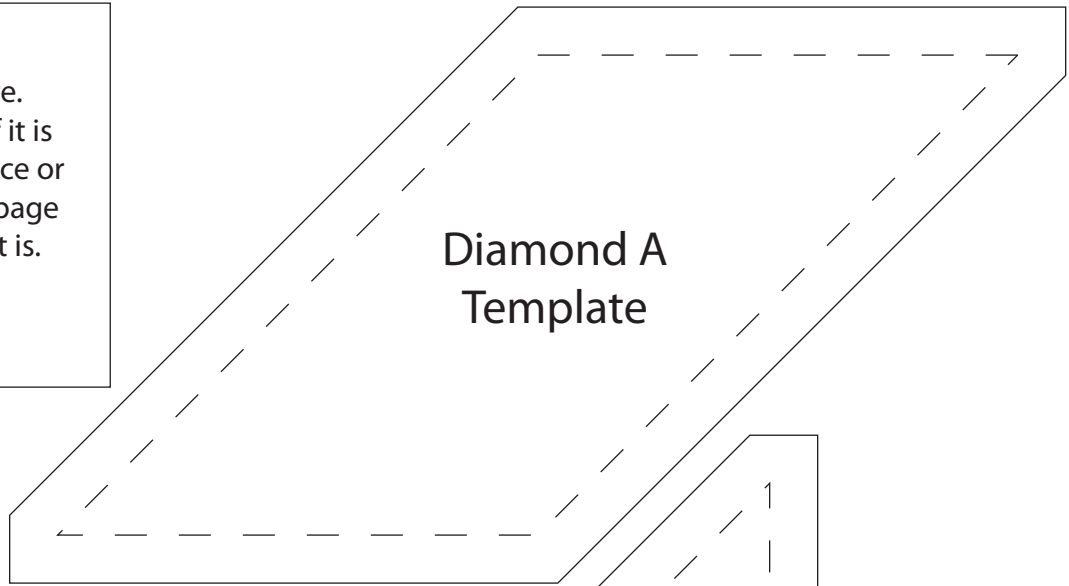
Finishing the Quilt:

1. Add 1-1/2" x 44" coral dot strips to the right and left sides then to the top and bottom. Press and trim excess after each border addition.
2. Add 4-1/2" x 44" large floral strips to the right and left sides then to the top and bottom. Press and trim excess after each border addition.
3. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.
4. Prepare binding from four 2-1/2" x 44" strips of coral dot strip. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.
5. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.
6. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.
7. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
