Finished Quilt Approximately: 34" x 42" - Finished Block Size: 4" x 4"

Froggies fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3745

## **Fabric Requirements:** Based on 44" wide fabric

1-1/2 yards frogs and mushrooms (#8854-8)

5/8 yard frogs and butterflies (#8857-8)

1/4 yard pink mushrooms (#8859-1)

1/2 yard blue floral (#8858-2)

1/4 yard pink floral (#8858-1)

1/4 yard green mushroom (#8859-6)

1/2 yard blue dot (#8860-2)

1/4 yard pink dot (#8860-1)

2/3 yard green dot (#8860-6)

1-1/2 yards fabric for backing (#8853-8 border stripe suggested)

38" x 46" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

## **Cutting Directions:** All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **frogs and mushrooms** fabric:

Cut two 4-1/2" x 40" strips lengthwise, parallel to the selvage

Cut two 4-1/2" x 44" strips the width of the fabric

From the **frogs and butterflies** fabric:

Cut three 4-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into twenty 4-1/2" squares

From the **pink mushrooms** fabric:

Cut one 4-1/2" x 44" strip then recut into four 4-1/2" squares

From the **blue floral** fabric:

Cut two 4-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into twelve 4-1/2" squares

From the **pink floral** fabric:

Cut one 4-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into eight 4-1/2" squares

From the **green mushroom fabric:**

Cut one 4-1/2" x 44" strip then recut into four 4-1/2" squares

From the **blue dot** fabric:

Cut two 2-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into thirty-two 2-1/2" squares

Cut four 1-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **pink dot** fabric:

Cut two 2-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into thirty-two 2-1/2" squares

From the **green dot** fabric:

Cut two 2-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into thirty-two 2-1/2" squares

Cut four 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

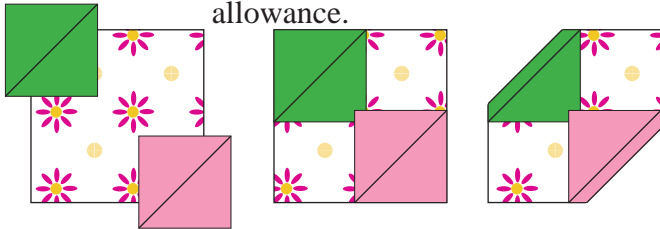

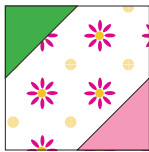
## Blocks:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each of the 2-1/2" squares.

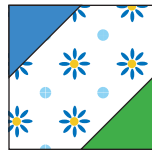
2. For each block, lay two marked 2-1/2" squares right sides together on a 4-1/2" square. Stitch along the marked lines. Trim excess to 1/4" seam allowance.



3. Make the following number of each block using the technique above. The floral fabrics are not directional. The frog/butterfly and mushroom prints are directional so the various configurations are shown based on the direction of the 4-1/2" fabrics.

## Assembly & Finishing:

1. Lay out all the blocks as shown in the Block Layout on Page 3 . Stitch the blocks into rows. Sew the rows together.

2. Sew a 1-1/2" blue dot strip to the right and left sides of the quilt. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions. Add 1-1/2" blue dot strips to top and bottom of quilt.

3. Add the 4-1/2" x 40" frog/mushroom strips to the right and left sides. Add 4-1/2" x 44" frog/mushroom strips to the top and bottom of quilt.

4. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

5. Prepare binding from four 2-1/2" x 44" strips of green dot. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

6. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

7. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

8. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
