Finished Quilt: 71" x 87" - Finished Block Size: 16" x 16"

Heaven Sent fabrics by Classic Cottons - Style #3659

Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric

2-1/4 yards cream cat toile (#8385-90 Cream)

1/2 yard tan cat toile (#8385-9 Tan)

1/2 yard tan paw print (#8402-4 Gold)

1 yard overall cat print (#8383-9 Cream)

1-1/4 yards blue paw print (#8402-2 Blue)

5/8 yard blue floral (#8401-2 Blue)

1-1/2 yards green paw print (#8402-6 Green)

3/4 yard blue "meow" print (#8388-2 Blue)

1/2 yard tan "meow" print (#8388-9 Tan)

1-3/8 yards large floral (#8382-1 Pink)

5-1/4 yards fabric for backing (#8382-1 Pink large floral suggested)

78" x 94" quilt batting

template plastic

4 yards fusible web

Prepare Templates: Prepare templates as directed on the Template Page.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **cream cat toile** fabric:

Cut three 16-1/2" x 44" strips then cut into six 16-1/2" squares

Cut thirteen 2" x 44" strips for borders

From the **blue paw print** fabric:

Cut eight 2-1/2" x 44" strips then cut into twenty-four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles and seventy-two 2-1/2" squares

Cut seven 3" x 44" strips for border

From the **blue floral** fabric:

Cut two 8-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into six 8-1/2" squares

From the **green paw print** fabric:

Cut two 4-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into twelve 4-7/8" (each cut in half diagonally)

Cut eight 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Cut eight 2" x 44" strips for border

From the **blue "meow" print** fabric:

Cut two 2-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into twenty-four 2-7/8" sqs. (each cut in half diagonally)

Cut into six 2-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into ninety-six 2-1/2" squares

From the **tan "meow" print** fabric:

Cut three 4-1/2" x 44" strips then cut into twenty-four 4-1/2" squares

From the **large floral** fabric:

Cut eight 5" x 44" strips for border

NOTE: Depending on the fabrics you use some may be directional. When using directional fabrics plan ahead so the fabrics face the correct direction in the block.

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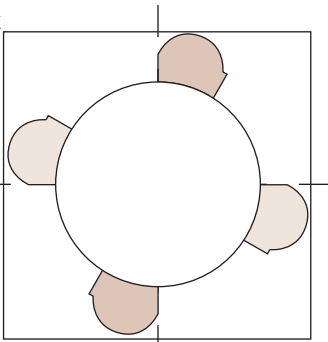
Sewing Directions:

1. Trace the circle template six times and the petal template 72 times face down on paper side of fusible web leaving about 1/2" between tracings.

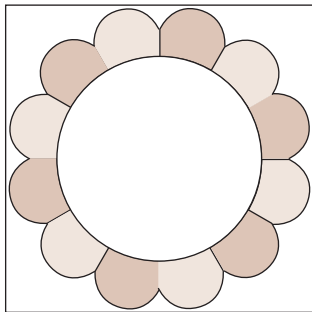
2. Roughly cut out each shape, leaving about 1/4" around the marked lines. Cut out the inside of the circle, leaving about a 1" ring, to reduce bulk.

3. Lay the fusible web rings on wrong side of the all-over cat fabric, centering them over the motifs. Lay 36 petals on wrong side of cream cat toile fabric and 36 petals on wrong side of tan cat paw print. Lightly fuse all the appliques to the fabrics. Cut out each shape along marked lines.

4. Center an all-over cat circle on a 16-1/2" cream cat toile square. Lay a tan petal on top and bottom and a cream petal on right and left sides. Arrange petals so the leading edge is even with the center of the block and the bottom edge is 1/4" under the cat fabric.



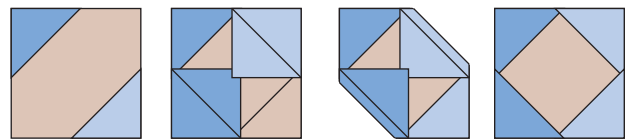
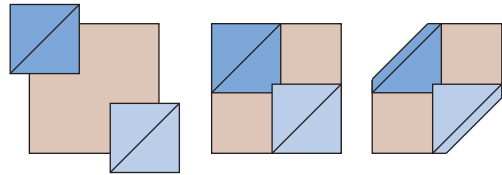
5. Fill in two more petals between each of the initial petals, alternating between tan and cream petals. The petals should all overlap the seam allowance edge of the previous petal. All petals should be 1/4" under the cat print center. Once all the petals are arranged, permanently fuse the pieces to the background according to fusible web manufacturer's directions.



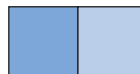
6. Make a total of six applique blocks.

7. Machine applique around all the raw edges of the applique blocks. Use a clear nylon thread through the needle and a neutral all-purpose thread in the bobbin. Set your sewing machine to a short, narrow zigzag stitch. Use a tear-away stabilizer under the applique if needed.

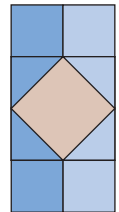
8. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 48 blue paw print and 48 blue "meow" 2-1/2" squares. Lay a marked blue paw print and blue "meow" square on opposite sides of a 4-1/2" tan "meow" square. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Repeat on remaining corners with a marked blue paw print and blue "meow" square. Make a total of 24 square-in-a-square units.



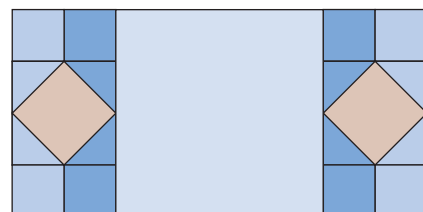
9. Stitch a 2-1/2" blue paw print square to a 2-1/2" blue "meow" square. Make a second set. Stitch these units to the sides of a square-in-a-square unit, matching the blue prints to make a side unit. Repeat to make a total of twelve side units.

10. Add side units to opposite sides of a 8-1/2" blue floral square, with the blue paw print next to the 8-1/2" center square. Make six centers.



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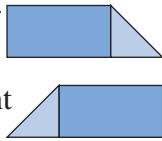
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Sewing Directions:

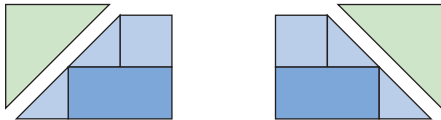
11. Stitch a 2-7/8" blue "meow" half square triangle to the right side of twelve 2-1/2" blue "meow" squares. Make twelve more with the pieces reversed.



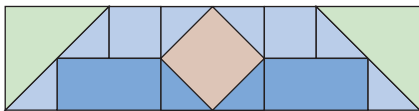
12. Stitch a 2-7/8" blue "meow" half square triangle to the right side of twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" blue paw print rectangles. Make twelve more with the pieces reversed.



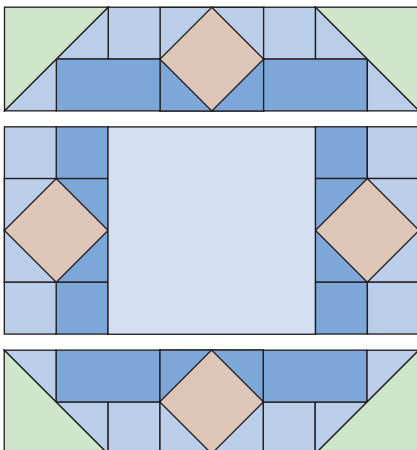
13. Combine the units above to make twelve as shown. Add a 4-7/8" green paw print triangle to each as shown.



14. Stitch the units to the remaining square-in-a-square units.



15. Add these to the top and bottom of the center square.



16. Lay out all blocks in four rows of three blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks into rows then sew the rows together.

17. Make four borders each with one and one half-length strips of 2" cream cat toile fabric. Add these (and all successive borders) to right and left sides then to the top and bottom. Press and trim after each border addition.

18. Add the following borders:

- * 3" blue paw print: two strips on each side one and one half strips top and bottom
- * 2" cream cat toile: two strips on each side one and one half strips top and bottom
- * 5" large floral: two strips on all sides
- * 2" green paw print: two strips on all sides

19. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Stitch the two pieces together along a selvage edge to make a backing two fabric widths wide. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

20. Prepare binding from eight 2-1/2" x 44" strips of green paw print fabric. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

21. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

22. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

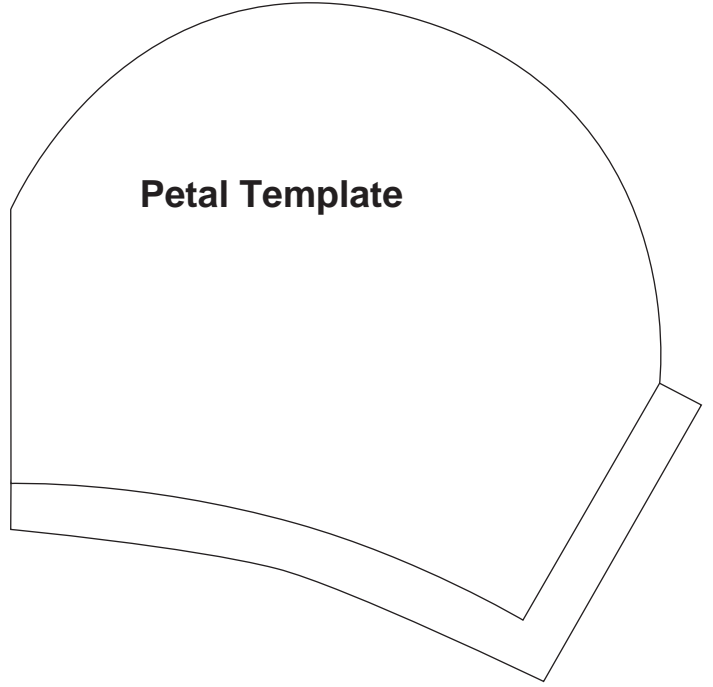
23. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
