Finished Quilt Approx: 53-1/2" x 53-1/2" - Finished Block: 12" x 12"

Pumpkin Patch fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3710



An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric

1-1/8 yards pumpkin print (#8646-8)

3/4 yard cream dot (#8649-9)

1/2 yard green spider (#8648-6)

3/4 yard purple candy (#8645-3)

1-1/8 yards orange spider (#8648-7)

2-1/4 yards black spider (#8648-8)

3-3/4 yards fabric for backing (#8643-9 suggested)

60" x 60" quilt batting

5" x 14" fusible web

template plastic

Make Templates: Trace templates onto template plastic. Cut out and label. When cutting fabric with templates, templates with a lower case "r" are placed face down on the right side of the fabric.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **pumpkin print** fabric:

Cut six 3-1/2" x 44" strips for border

Using templates cut: eight A

From the **cream dot** fabric:

Cut nine 2" x 44" strips then recut into twenty-four 2" x 12-1/2" sashing strips and sixteen 2" sashing cornerstones

From the **green spider** fabric:

Cut one 3" x 44" strip then recut into two 3" squares, one 2-7/8" square* and one 1-7/8" sq.*

Using templates cut: four A

From the **purple candy** fabric:

Using templates cut: four B, four Br, four D and four Dr

From the **orange spider** fabric:

Cut one 10-1/2" x 44" strip then recut into one 10-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle, four 4" x 5-1/2", four 3-1/2" x 4" pieces and four 2-1/2" x 5" pieces

Cut three 1-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into four 1-1/2" x 8", eight 1-1/2" x 5", four 1-1/2" x 3" strips and four 1" squares

Using templates cut: two E, two Er, two G, two Gr, two I, two Ir, two J, two Jr, two M, two Mr, two O, two Or, four Q, two S, two Sr, one U and one Ur

From the **black spider** fabric:

Cut six 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

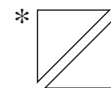
Cut five 2-1/4" x 44" strips for border

Cut one 2" x 44" strips then recut into four 2" x 6" strips

Cut ten 1-1/2" x 44" strips, recut four strips into four 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips, four 1-1/2" x 8" strips, eight 1-1/2" x 4" strips, four 1-1/2" x 3" and eight 1-1/2" x 2" pieces

Using templates cut: four C, two F, two Fr, four H, two K, two Kr, two L, two Lr, two N, two Nr, two P, two Pr, two R, two Rr and one T

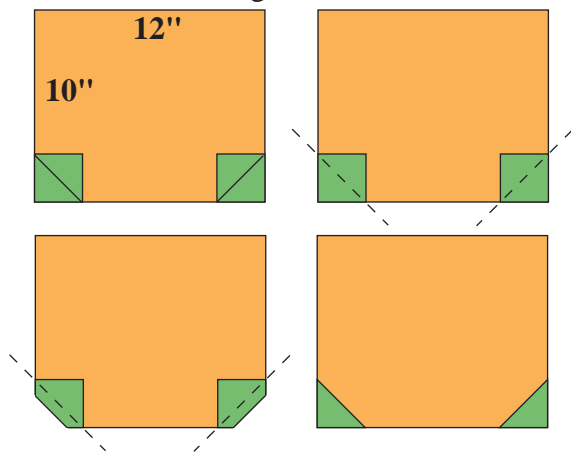

Pumpkin Block:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of two 3" green spider squares.

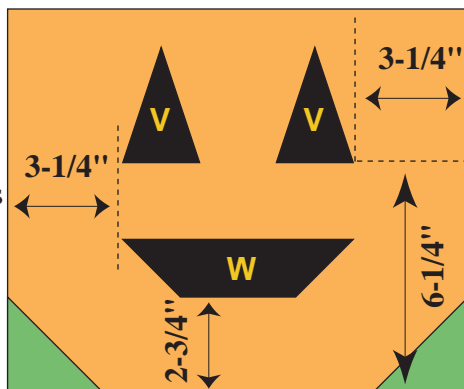


2. Lay the two marked squares even with the bottom corners of the 10-1/2" x 12-1/2" orange spider piece as shown. Stitch along the marked lines. Trim the excess to a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the corner triangles out.



3. Lightly press the fusible web to wrong side of remaining orange spider fabric. Trace two Template V and one Template W pieces onto the paper side of the fusible web. Cut out along the marked lines.

4. Lay out the V and W pieces using the measurements as shown:



5. Press the appliques in place permanently, following the web manufacturer's directions.

6. Hand or machine stitch around applique raw edges using an overcast or zigzag stitch.

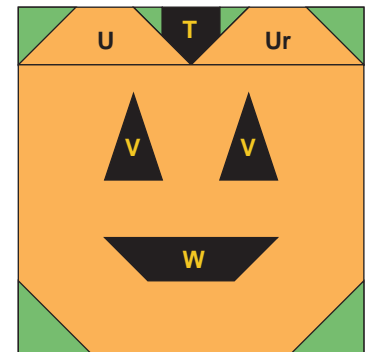
7. Stitch a 1-7/8" green spider half-square triangle to each side of black spider Template T to make stem unit.



8. Combine the stem unit, U, Ur and 2-7/8" green spider half-square triangles as shown:

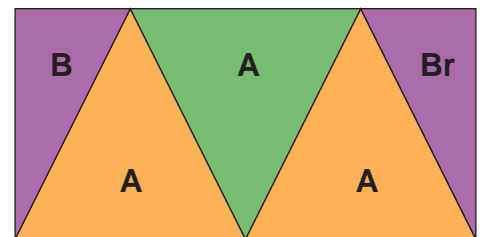


9. Add the pumpkin top to the face unit. Make a total of one Pumpkin Block.

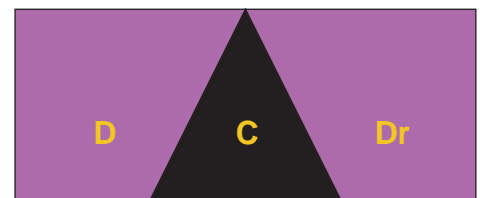


Witch Block:

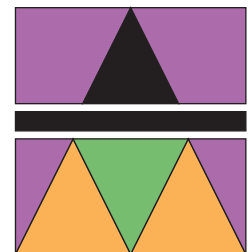
1. Stitch two pumpkin print and one green Template A pieces with one each Template B and Br purple candy pieces as shown:



2. Stitch the Template D and Dr pieces to the sides of the Template C black spider piece.



3. Stitch a 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" black spider strip between the top and bottom sections of the block.



4. Make a total of four Witch Blocks.

Right Facing Cat Blocks:

1. Stitch the orange spider Template E, G and I pieces with the black spider Template F and H pieces. Add the 1-1/2" x 5" orange spider and 1-1/2" x 3" black spider strips as shown to complete the ear unit.



2. Stitch a 1-1/2" x 8" orange spider strip to a 1-1/2" x 8" black spider strip. Add a 2-1/2" x 5" orange spider piece for tail unit. (shown sideways)



3. Stitch the foot unit together with two 1-1/2" x 2" black spider strips, a 1-1/2" x 5" orange spider and 1-1/2" x 3" orange spider piece.



4. Stitch the leg unit together with two 1-1/2" x 4" black spider strips, a 4" x 5-1/2" orange spider and 3-1/2" x 4" orange spider piece. Add the foot unit below this.



5. Stitch a black spider Template L and N pieces with the orange spider Template M and O pieces.



6. Using the quick-corner technique used for the bottom of the pumpkin block, add a 1" square to make an orange spider triangle on a 2" x 6" black spider.



7. Combine these two pieces for the face unit.



8. Stitch the orange spider Template J piece to the black spider Template K piece.



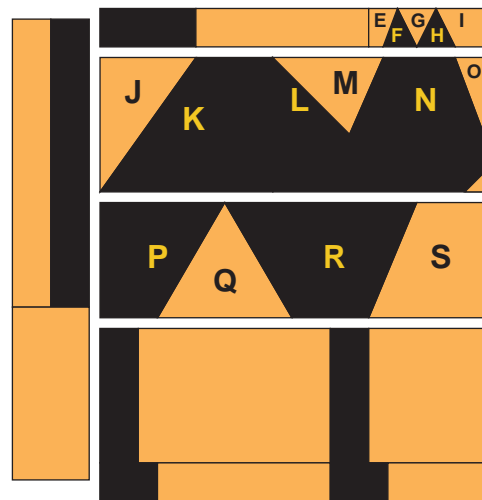
7. Add the J/K unit to the face unit.



8. Make the upper leg unit with black spider Template pieces P and R and orange spider Template Q and S pieces.



9. Combine the units as shown:



10. Make a total of two Right Facing Cat Blocks.

Left Facing Cat Blocks:

1. Stitch the orange spider Template Er, Gr and Ir pieces with the black spider Template Fr and H pieces. Add the 1-1/2" x 5" orange spider and 1-1/2" x 3" black spider strips as shown to complete the ear unit.



2. Stitch a 1-1/2" x 8" orange spider strip to a 1-1/2" x 8" black spider strip. Add a 2-1/2" x 5" orange spider piece for tail unit. (shown sideways)

3. Stitch the foot unit together with two 1-1/2" x 2" black spider strips, a 1-1/2" x 5" orange spider and 1-1/2" x 3" orange spider piece.



4. Stitch the leg unit together with two 1-1/2" x 4" black spider strips, a 4" x 5-1/2" orange spider and 3-1/2" x 4" orange spider piece. Add the foot unit below this.



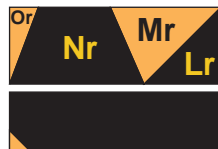
5. Stitch a black spider Template Lr and Nr pieces with the orange spider Template Mr and Or pieces.



6. Using the quick-corner technique used for the bottom of the pumpkin block, add a 1" square to make an orange spider triangle on a 2" x 6" black spider.



7. Combine these two pieces for the face unit.



8. Stitch the orange spider Template Jr piece to the black spider Template Kr piece.



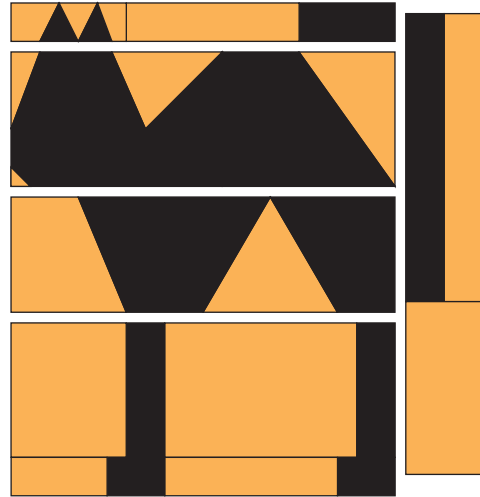
7. Add the Jr/Kr unit to the face unit.



8. Make the upper leg unit with black spider Template pieces Pr and Rr and orange spider Template Q and Sr pieces.



9. Combine the units as shown:



10. Make a total of two Left Facing Cat Blocks.

Sashing and Borders:

1. Referring to the quilt diagram, lay out all the blocks with 2" x 12-1/2" cream dot sashing strips around each block and 2" cream dot cornerstone squares between the sashing strips. Sew blocks, sashing and cornerstones into rows. Stitch rows together completing the quilt center.

2. Cut one 2-1/4" x 44" black spider strip into four equal lengths. Sew each quarter-length strip end-to-end with a full-length strip. Add borders to the right and left sides of quilt center. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions. Add remaining borders to the top and bottom.

3. Cut two 3-1/2" x 44" pumpkin strips each into two equal lengths. Sew each half-length strip end-to-end with a full-length strip. Add borders to right and left sides then to the top and bottom.

4. Make and add a 1-1/2" black spider strip border in the same manner as the pumpkin border.

This box is 2" square.

Assembly:

1. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Sew the two lengths together along selvage edges. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from six 2-1/2" x 44" black spider strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease.

Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

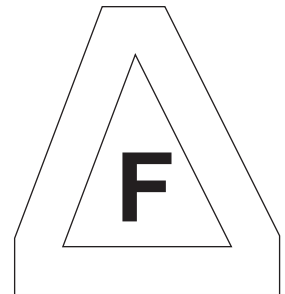
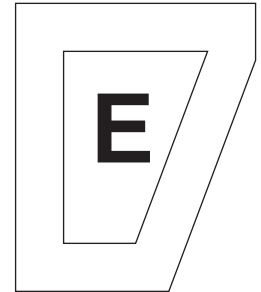
5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
