Finished Quilt Approximately: 66" x 78" - Finished Block Size: 12" x 12"

Shipwreck Quilts fabrics from **Calico Hill Collection** by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3740

Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric

- 1-7/8 yards large floral (#8809-99)
- 1-1/8 yards cream (#8816-9)
- 1-1/8 yards tan tonal (#8814-9)
- 1/2 yard cream mini floral (#8813-9)
- 1/2 yard brown mini floral (#8813-99)
- 2/3 yard cream scattered floral (#8810-9)
- 1/2 yard brown scattered floral (#8810-99)
- 1/2 yard red dots (#8815-1)
- 1-3/8 yards red tonal (#8814-1)
- 1/2 yard brown dots (#8815-99)
- 7/8 yard pink (#8816-1)
- 5-1/8 yards fabric for backing (#8809-99 large floral suggested)
- 74" x 86" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

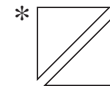
Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **large floral** fabric:

- Cut two 6-1/2" x 44" strips recut into ten 6-1/2" squares
- Cut eight 5-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **cream** fabric:

- Cut four 3-7/8" x 44" strips recut into forty 3-7/8" squares*
- Cut six 2-1/2" x 44" strips for border



From the **tan tonal** fabric:

- Cut two 3-7/8" x 44" strips recut into twenty 3-7/8" squares*
- Cut five 2-3/8" x 44" strips recut into eighty 2-3/8" squares*
- Cut seven 1-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **cream mini floral, brown mini floral, brown scattered floral** and **red dots** fabric:

- Cut two 3-7/8" x 44" strips recut into twenty 3-7/8" squares*

From the **cream scattered floral** fabric:

- Cut four 3-7/8" x 44" strips recut into forty 3-7/8" squares*

From the **red tonal** fabric:

- Cut two 3-7/8" x 44" strips recut into twenty 3-7/8" squares*
- Cut eight 2-1/2" x 44" strips binding
- Cut eight 1-1/2" x 44" strips border

From the **brown dots** fabric:

- Cut one 4-1/4" x 44" strips recut into ten 4-1/4" squares**
- Cut two 2" x 44" strips recut into forty 2" squares



From the **pink** fabric:

- Cut one 4-1/4" x 44" strips recut into ten 4-1/4" squares**
- Cut five 2-3/8" x 44" strips recut into eighty 2-3/8" squares*
- Cut two 2" x 44" strips recut into forty 2" squares



Shipwreck Quilt



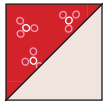
Pinwheel Blocks:

1. Use the 3-7/8" half-square triangles to make **forty** of each triangle unit:



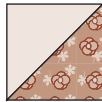
cream mini floral/brown scattered floral

brown mini floral/red tonal

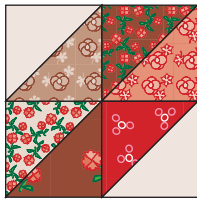


cream/red dot

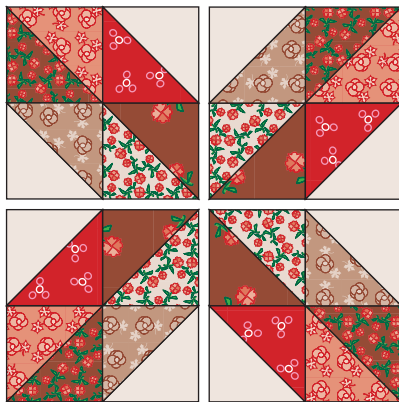
cream/tan tonal



2. Using the triangle units, piece forty sections as shown:



3. Arrange four sections to form a block. Stitch sections into rows then sew the rows together. Make a total of ten Pinwheel Blocks.



Star Blocks:

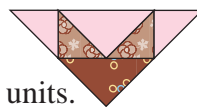
1. Stitch a 2-3/8 tan tonal half-square triangle to the sides of four 4-1/4" pink quarter-square triangles.



2. Sew two 2-3/8" pink half-square triangle to each unit as shown:



3. Add a 4-1/4" brown dot quarter-square triangle to the bottom of the units.



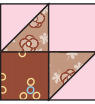
4. Finish the star point units with two 3-7/8" cream scattered floral half-squares triangles.



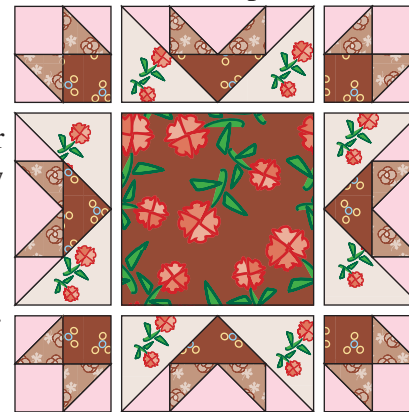
5. Make eight triangle sets with 2-3/8" pink and tan tonal half-square triangles.



6. Lay out two pink/tan tonal triangle sets, one 2" pink square and one 2" brown dot square as shown. Stitch the pieces together into rows then sew the rows together. Make a total of four of these corner units.



7. Lay out four corner units, four star point units and one 6-1/2" large floral square as shown. Stitch the pieces together into rows then sew the rows together.



8. Make a total of ten Star Blocks.

Quilt Center:

1. Lay out all the blocks in five rows of four blocks each - alternating the blocks as shown in the quilt diagram.

2. Stitch the blocks into rows then sew the rows together.

Borders:

1. Cut two 2-1/2" x 44" cream strips into two equal lengths. Sew each half-length strip end-to-end with a full-length strip. Sew borders to the right and left sides of quilt center. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions. Add remaining cream borders to the top and bottom of quilt.

2. Make two border strips each with two 1-1/2" x 44" tan tonal strips. Stitch these to the right and left sides of quilt. Cut one 1-1/2" x 44" tan tonal strip in half lengthwise and each to a full-length strip. Add borders to top and bottom of quilt.

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Borders: (continued)

3. Make four borders each with two 5-1/2" x 44" large floral strips sewn together end-to-end. Add borders to the right and left sides of quilt then to the top and bottom.

4. Make four borders each with two 1-1/2" x 44" red tonal strips sewn together end-to-end. Add borders to the right and left sides of quilt then to the top and bottom.

Finishing:

1. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Sew the two lengths together along selvage edges. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from eight 2-1/2" x 44" strips of red tonal. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
