Sunday in the Park fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3707

Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric
2-1/8 yards scenic print (#8626-2), includes backing
5/8 yard brown (#8631-9)
2/3 yard lime (#8631-6)
1/4 yard blue (#8631-4)
1/4 yard navy (#8631-29)
1/4 yard red (#8631-7)
1/4 yard gold (#8631-49)
1/4 yard green (#8631-60)
27" x 56" batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **scenic print** fabric:

Cut one 11-1/2" x 44" strip

Cut two 27" x 44" strips for backing

From the **brown** fabric:

Cut one 3-3/4" x 44" strips then recut into six 3-3/4" squares

Cut seven 1-1/2" x 44" strips

From the **lime** fabric:

Cut four 2-1/2" x 44" strips

Cut four 1-1/2" x 44" strips

From each of the **blue, navy, red, gold and green** fabrics:

Cut one 3-3/4" x 44" strips then recut into six 3-3/4" squares

Sewing Directions:

1. Stitch a 1-1/2" brown strip to long edges of scenic 11-1/2" x 44" piece. Press and trim the scenic/brown piece to 37-1/2" long. Cut one 1-1/2" x 44" brown strip into two equal halves. Sew a half-strip to short ends of scenic print. Press and trim excess from these and all successive borders.
2. Make pieced borders from 3-3/4" squares. The short borders are in the following order: brown, red, gold and green. The long borders each are in the following order: blue, navy, brown, red, gold, green, blue, navy, brown, red, gold, green, blue then navy. Add short then long borders.
3. Make two borders each with two 1-1/2" x 44" brown strips sewn together end-to-end. Sew a border to long edges. Press and trim excess. Add the excess from each border to the short sides. Repeat with 1-1/2" lime border.
4. Stitch two 27" x 44" scenic strips together end-to-end to create the backing. Layer the backing, batting and top. Spray baste or pin baste layers together.
6. Machine or hand quilt stitch-in-the-ditch along all seam lines and along lines within the scenic print. Trim backing and batting even with the quilt top.
7. Prepare binding from four 2-1/2" x 44" strips of lime. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise. Add to edges of quilt. Turn binding to back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
