Finished Wall Quilt Approximately: 40-1/2" x 40-1/2"

Sunday in the Park fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3707

Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric
2-1/3 yards scenic print (#8626-2), includes backing
5/8 yard umbrella print (#8628-2)
5/8 yard brown (#8631-9)
1/3 yard green (#8631-60)
3/4 yard navy (#8631-29)
1/3 yard red (#8631-7)
1/4 yard gold (#8631-49)
1/4 yard blue (#8631-20)
1/4 yard lime (#8631-6)
42" x 42" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **scenic print** fabric:

Cut one 30-3/4" x 44" strip then recut into one 30-3/4" square

From the **umbrella print** fabric:

Cut four 3-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **brown** fabric:

Cut one 5-7/8" x 44" strip then recut into four 5-7/8" squares and four 3-3/8" squares

Cut four 1-3/4" x 44" strips for border

From the **blue** fabric:

Cut one 3-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into four 3-1/2" squares

From the **navy** fabric:

Cut four 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Cut four 1-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From each of the **green** and **red** fabrics:

Cut one 5-1/2" x 44" strip recut into two 5-1/2" squares, four 3" x 5-1/2" pieces and two 3" squares

From each of the **lime** and **gold** fabrics:

Cut one 3" x 44" strip recut into four 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

Sewing Directions:

1. Mark the center point of each of the sides of the 30-3/4" scenic print square. Trim the four corners from the square, leaving a scenic print diamond.

2. Cut each of the 3-3/8" and 5-7/8" brown squares in half diagonally creating two triangles.

3. Lay out a corner unit with one 3" red square, one 5-1/2" red square, two 3" x 5-1/2" red pieces, two 3" x 5-1/2" gold pieces, two 3-3/8" and two 5-1/2" brown triangles. Stitch pieces into rows then sew rows together. Repeat to make a second red/gold corner unit. Make two more corner units with brown, green and lime.

4. Add the four corner units to the trimmed scenic diamond.

5. Stitch a 1-3/4" x 44" brown strip to right and left sides of center.

Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions.

Add 1-3/4" brown strips to top and bottom of quilt.

6. Trim two 3-1/2" umbrella strips equal to width of quilt. Add a 3-1/2" blue square to both ends of these trimmed strips and set aside for top and bottom borders. Add 3-1/2" x 44" umbrella strips to right and left sides of quilt, press and trim. Add prepared top and bottom borders.

7. Add final 1-1/2" navy border to the right and left sides then to the top and bottom of quilt.

8. Layer the quilt top, batting and remaining scenic fabric. Baste layers together. Quilt or tie as desired. Trim the backing and batting even with the edges of quilt top.

9. Make binding from four 2-1/2" x 44" navy strips and apply to edges of quilt.
