

# “Nature’s Studio—The Wave”

Approximate Finished Size: 37-3/4" x 42" - Finished Block Size: 2-1/8" x 2-1/8"

Classic Cottons **Nature’s Studio** Fabrics (Style #3644)

**Fabric Requirements:** (Yardage is based on 42" wide fabric)  
1/8 yard each of thirty-five colored fabrics (5 shades of 7 colors)  
1/3 yd. of darkest pink (burgundy) print (#6383-17)  
7/8 yd. of dark pink print (#6384-17)  
1-1/2 yards backing fabric (pale pink print #6387-17 suggested)  
42" x 48" piece of quilt batting

NOTE: This quilt is designed to be made as an independent quilt, or as a reversible with the “Nature’s Studio—Stacked Pyramids” quilt as the backing. If using the “Stacked Pyramids” quilt as the backing do not purchase the backing fabric listed here.

**Cutting Directions:** Note: A 1/4" seam allowance is included in all measurements.

Cut the following strips of fabric, then cut as directed:

From the **each of the thirty-five colored** fabrics cut:

One 3" x 44" strip recut into seven 3" squares

From the **darkest pink** fabric cut:

Four 1-1/2" x 44" strips

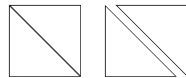
From the **dark pink** fabric cut:

Four 3-1/2" x 44" strips

Four 2-1/2" x 44" strips

## **Cutting Directions:**

1. Cut each of the 3" squares in half diagonally forming two equal triangles.



2. Using the Quilt Diagram as a guide, lay out all the triangles as shown in the quilt center. There will be one or two triangles leftover of each print.

3. Sew each set of triangles into a square and then replace them in your quilt layout.

4. Once all the triangles are sewn into squares, sew the squares into rows. Sew the rows into the finished quilt center.

5. Sew a 1-1/2" x 44" darkest pink strip to the long edges of the quilt center. Press and trim excess. Sew remaining darkest pink strips to the top and bottom of quilt. Press and trim excess.

6. Add the 3-1/2" x 44" dark pink border strips in the same manner as the first border.

7. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together. Quilt or tie as desired.

8. Prepare binding from four 2-1/2" x 44" strips of dark pink fabric. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

9. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

10. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

11. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place. Sign and date your work.
