Finished Quilt Approximately: 78" x 88" - Finished Block Size: 10" x 10"

Turn of the Century fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3750

**Fabric Requirements:** Based on 44" wide fabric

2/3 yard red paisley (#8861-1)  
2/3 yard blue paisley (#8861-2)  
1-7/8 yards black paisley (#8861-8)  
3/8 yard red gingham (#8862-1)  
3/8 yard blue gingham (#8862-2)  
3/8 yard black gingham (#8862-8)  
3/8 yard pink small floral (#8863-1)  
3/8 yard blue small floral (#8863-2)  
1-1/3 yard tan small floral (#8863-9)  
3/8 yard pink small paisley (#8864-1)  
3/8 yard blue small paisley (#8864-2)  
3-1/8 yards black small paisley (#8864-8)  
3/4 yard pink small vine (#8865-1)  
3/8 yard blue small vine (#8865-2)  
3/8 yard black small vine (#8865-8)  
1-5/8 yard tan on cream print (#8866-9)  
3/8 yard red floral (#8868-1)  
3/8 yard blue floral (#8868-2)  
3/8 yard black floral (#8868-8)  
5-1/2 yards fabric for backing (#8904-9 patchwork print suggested)  
84" x 94" quilt batting  
template plastic

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

**Make Template:** Trace template onto template plastic. Cut out and label.

**Cutting Directions:** All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From each of the **red, blue and black paisley** fabrics:

Cut seven 2-1/8" x 44" strips then recut into fourteen 2-1/8" x 10-1/2" and fourteen 2-1/8" x 7-1/4" strips

From the **black paisley** fabric:

Cut eight 5-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **black small paisley** fabric:

Cut two 4-3/4" x 44" strips recut into eleven 4-3/4" squares\*\*

Cut ten 3-3/4" x 44" strips recut into one-hundred sixty eight 2-1/4" x 3-3/4" rectangles

Cut nine 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Cut sixteen 1-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **pink small vine** fabric:

Cut two 4-3/4" x 44" strips recut into eleven 4-3/4" squares\*\*

From the **tan small floral** fabric:

Cut ten 3-3/4" x 44" strips recut into one-hundred sixty eight 2-1/4" x 3-3/4" rectangles

From the **tan on cream print** fabric:

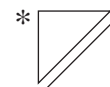
Cut eight 3-3/4" x 44" strips recut into eighty-four 3-3/4" squares

Cut seven 2-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From each of the **red, blue and black gingham - pink and blue small floral - pink, blue and black small paisley - pink, blue and black small vine - red, blue and black floral** fabrics:

Cut one 7-5/8" x 44" strip recut into two 7-5/8" squares\*

Cut squares as indicated:



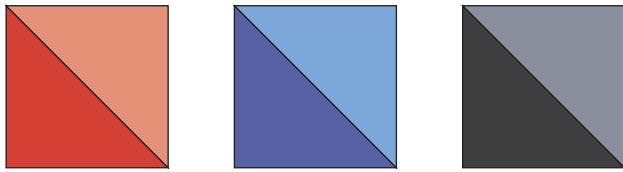

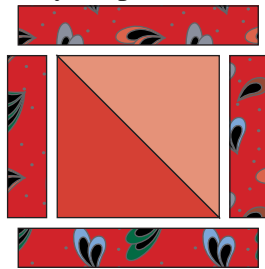
## Hollow Cube Block:

**NOTE:** The Hollow Cube Block directions are for a scrappy look and are not intended to match the quilt diagram fabric by fabric.

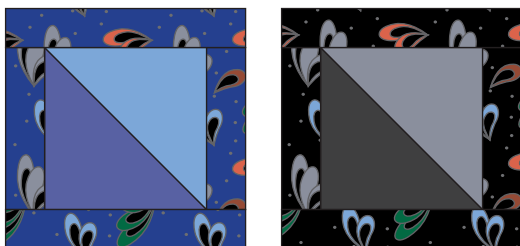
1. Using the 7-5/8" half-square triangles, mix and match them to make seven red/pink squares, seven blue squares and seven black squares. Strive to have a visible contrast between the two sides of the block centers. Discard unused triangles.



2. Sew a 2-1/8" x 7-1/4" red paisley strip to the right and left sides of the red block centers. Add the 2-1/8" x 10-12" red paisley strips to the top and bottom to complete the seven red blocks.



3. Add the blue paisley strips to the blue block centers and the black paisley strips to the black block centers in the same manner to complete seven blue and seven black blocks.



## Nine-Patch Star Blocks:

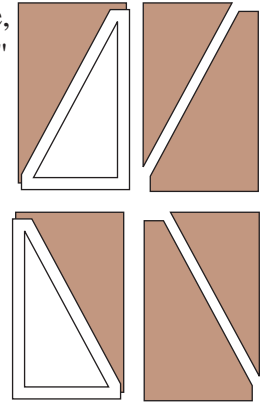
1. Stitch a pink small vine 4-3/4" quarter-square triangle to a black small paisley 4-3/4" quarter-square triangle as shown. Make forty-two units. Discard unused triangles.



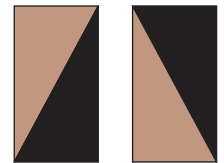
2. Combine units to make twenty-one block center quarter-square triangle sets as shown.



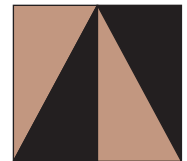
3. Using the Triangle Template, trim eighty-four 2-1/4" x 3-3/4" tan small floral rectangles with the template face *up* on the *right* side of the fabric. Trim the other eighty-four 2-1/4" x 3-3/4" tan small floral rectangles with the template face *down* on the *right* side of the fabric. Trim the 2-1/4" x 3-3/4" black small paisley rectangles in the same manner.



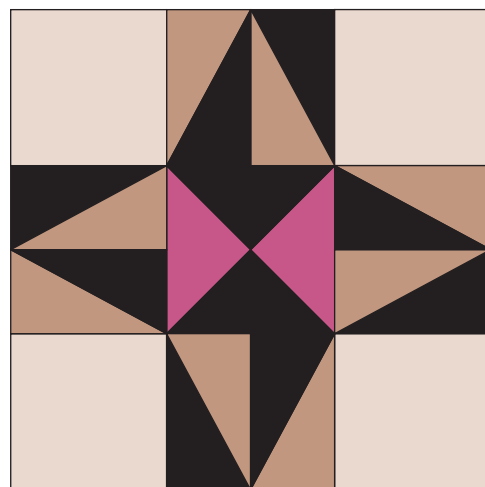
4. Combine the cream and black triangles into eighty-four of each triangle unit.



5. Using the triangle units, make eighty-four star point units.



6. Lay out four star point units, one pink/black quarter-square triangle unit and four 3-3/4" tan on cream print squares for each block. Sew the pieces into rows then sew the rows together. Make a total of twenty-one Nine-Patch Star Blocks.

## Assembly and Borders

1. Lay out the blocks in seven horizontal rows of six blocks each, alternating the blocks. Refer to the quilt graphic for placement of the red, blue and black Hollow Cube Blocks (center of blocks will not match graphic exactly).
2. Stitch the blocks into rows then sew the rows into the completed quilt center.
3. Make two borders each with two 2-1/2" tan on cream print strips sewn together end-to-end. Add these borders to the right and left sides of quilt center. Press and trim these and all successive border additions. Cut one 2-1/2" x 44" tan on cream print strips into two equal lengths. Sew each half-length strip end-to-end with a full-length strip. Add borders to the top and bottom of quilt center.
4. Make eight borders each with two 1-1/2" small black paisley strips sewn together end-to-end. Reserve four borders for the last border. Add borders to the right and left sides of quilt then to the top and bottom.
5. Make and add a 5-1/2" black paisley border in the same manner as the last border.
6. Add reserved 1-1/2" black small paisley borders to the right and left sides of quilt then to the top and bottom.

## Finishing:

1. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Sew the two lengths together along selvage edges. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.
2. Prepare binding from nine 2-1/2" x 44" strips of black small paisley. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.
3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.
4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.
5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
