

# Vintage Holidays

Quilt by Lucy A. Fazely & Michael L. Burns

Finished Quilt: 37-1/2" x 42-1/2" - Finished Block Size: 6" x 6"

Vintage Holidays fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3689

Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric

1/4 yard cream snowflake (#8528-9)

1/4 yard red snowflake (#8528-10)

1/4 yard green snowflake (#8528-6)

1/2 yard dark green snowflake (#8528-66)

2/3 yard cream ornament (#8529-9)

3/8 yard green ornament (#8529-6)

3/8 yard red ornament (#8529-10)

1/4 yard green candy canes (#8527-6)

3/8 yard red candy canes (#8527-10)

3/4 yard cream greeting cards (#8526-9)

5/8 yard red brick (#8532-10)

3/8 yard green Santa (#8524-6)

1-1/2 yards fabric for backing (#8526-6 green greeting card print suggested)

42" x 48" quilt batting and template plastic

Prepare Templates: Prepare templates as directed on Pages 3 & 4.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the cream snowflake fabric:

Cut eight Template Br

From the red snowflake fabric:

Cut eight Template A

From the green snowflake fabric:

Cut eight Template Ar

From the dark green snowflake fabric:

Cut six 1-1/2" x 44" strips

From the cream ornament fabric:

Cut four 6-1/8" squares, then cut each in half diagonally\*

Cut four Template D

From the green ornament fabric:

Cut two 6-1/8" squares, then cut each in half diagonally\*

From the red ornament fabric:

Cut four Template C and four Template Cr

From the green candy canes fabric:

Cut eight Template B

From the red candy canes fabric:

Cut two 2" x 44" strips

From the cream greeting cards fabric:

Cut four 4-1/2" x 44" strips

From the red brick fabric:

Cut four 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Cut four 1-1/2" x 44" strips

From the green Santa fabric:

Cut four 7-1/4" squares, then cut each in half diagonally\*

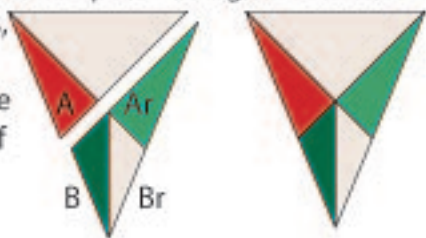


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## Center Star Block & Setting Corners:

1. Make the star unit by sewing a Template B green candycane piece to a Template Br cream snowflake. Add a Template Ar green snowflake. Sew a Template A red snowflake to a 6-1/8" cream ornament half-square triangle. Combine these two pieces, matching seam allowances. Make a total of eight of these units.



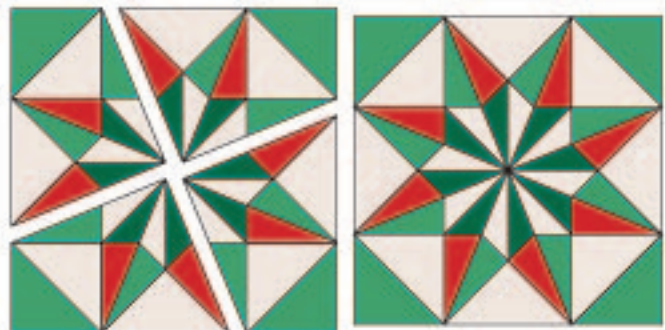
2. Add a 6-1/8" green ornament half-square triangle to four of the star units.



3. Sew two star point units, one with a green corner triangle, and one without, together as shown to make a quarter-star section. Make four quarter-star sections.



4. Combine the four quarter-star sections together, matching seam allowances.



5. Sew a Template C and Template Cr red ornament to each side of a Template D cream ornament. Make four corner units.



6. Stitch two 7-1/4" green Santa half-square triangles to each corner unit.



7. Add the four corner units to the star center.



## Borders:

1. Sew a 1-1/2" x 44" dark green snowflake border to top and bottom of quilt center. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions.

2. Add a 2" x 44" red candy cane strip to top and bottom.

3. Sew a 1-1/2" x 44" dark green snowflake strip to right and left sides then to the top and bottom.

4. Sew a 4-1/2" x 44" cream greeting card strip to right and left sides then to the top and bottom.

5. Sew a 1-1/2" x 44" red brick strip to right and left sides then to the top and bottom.

## Finishing:

1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from four 2-1/2" x 44" strips of red brick. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

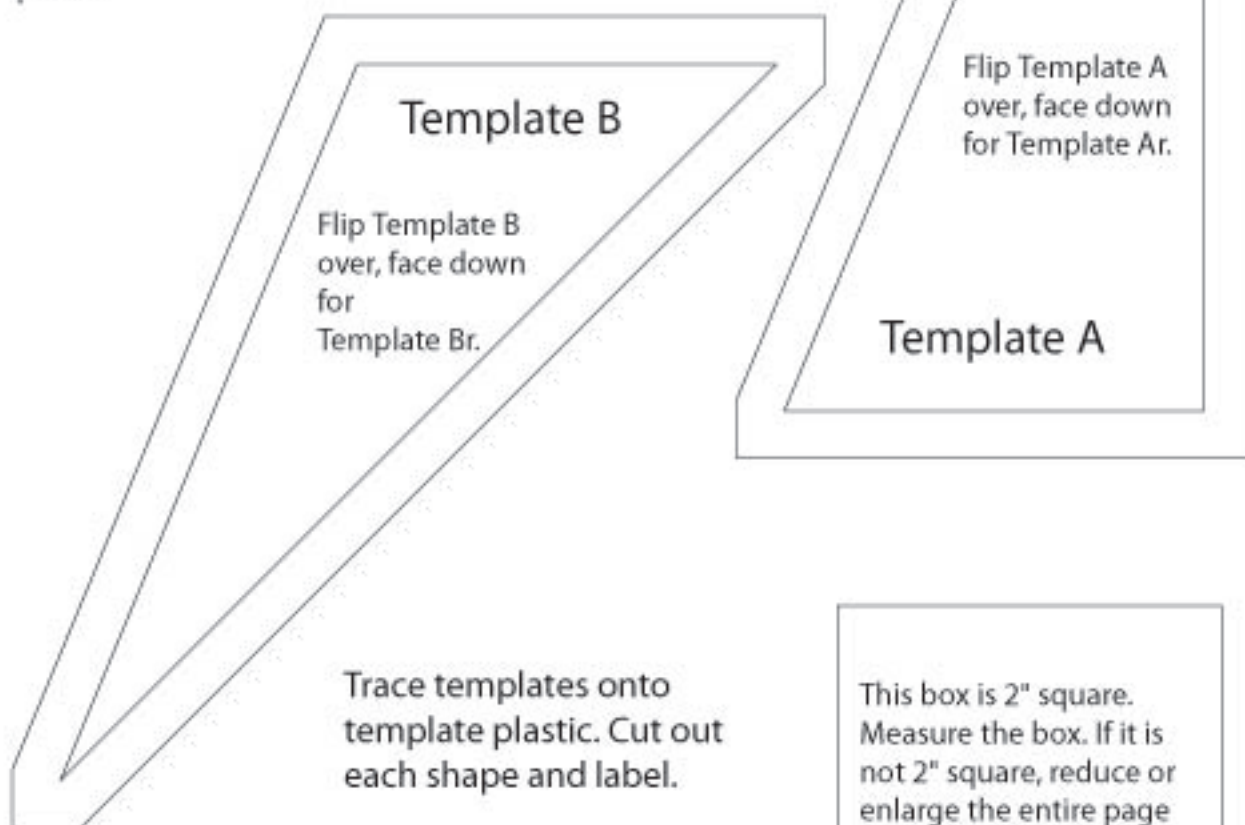
3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with

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4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing tape to quilt.

5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.



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Trace templates onto  
template plastic. Cut out  
each shape and label.
